Ezekiel 20:9" And I went acting for the sake of my own name that it might not be profaned before the eyes of the nations in among which they were, because I had made myself known to them before their eyes on bringing them forth from the land of Egypt.

- But, in fact, for this cause I have kept you in existence, for the sake of showing you my power and in order to have my name declared in all the earth. (Exodus 9:16)
- Hear this, O house of Jacob, YOU who are calling yourselves by the name of Israel and who have come forth from the very waters of Judah, YOU who are swearing by the name of Yehowah and who make mention even of the God of Israel, not in truth and not in righteousness. (Isaiah 48:1)
- For they have called themselves as being from the holy city, and upon the God of Israel they have supported themselves, Yehowah of armies being his name. (Isaiah 48:2)
- For the sake of my name I shall check my anger, and for my praise I shall restrain myself toward you that there may be no cutting you off. (Isaiah 48:9)
- Why should the Egyptians say; With evil intent he brought them out in order to kill them among the mountains and to exterminate them from the surface of the ground? Turn from your burning anger and feel regret over the evil against your people. (Exodus 32:12)
- But Moses said to Yehowah; Then the Egyptians will be bound to hear that you by your power have led this people up out of their midst. (Numbers 14:13)
- Yehowah was unable to bring them into the land that he had promised them, and because he hated them he brought them out to put them to death in the wilderness. (Deuteronomy 9:28)
- And the Canaanites and all the inhabitants of the land will hear of it, and they will certainly surround us and cut our name off from the earth, and what will you do for your great name? (Joshua 7:9)

- For Yehowah will not desert his people for the sake of his great name, because Yehowah has taken it upon himself to make you his people. (1 Samuel 12:22)
- For we have heard how Yehowah dried up the waters of the Red Sea from before you when you came out of Egypt, and what you did to the two kings of the Amorites who were on the other side of the Jordan, namely, Sihon and Og, whom you devoted to destruction. (Joshua 2:10)
- At this they said to him; It is from a very distant land that your servants have come in regard to the name of Yehowah your God, because we have heard of his fame and of all that he did in Egypt. (Joshua 9:9)
- Woe to us! Who will save us from the hand of this majestic God?
 This is the God that was the smiter of Egypt with every sort of slaughter in the wilderness. (1 Samuel 4:8)
- And I will remember in their behalf the covenant of the ancestors whom I brought forth out of the land of Egypt under the eyes of the nations, in order to prove myself their God. I am Yehowah. (Leviticus 26:45)
- Then the man of the true God approached and said to the king of Israel, yes, he went on to say; This is what Yehowah has said, For the reason that the Syrians have said; Yehowah is a God of mountains, and he is not a God of low plains, I shall have to give all this great crowd into your hand, and you men will certainly know that I am Yehowah. (1 Kings 20:28)
- And what other nation in the earth is like your people Israel, whom the true God went to redeem to himself as a people, to assign to yourself a name of great achievements and fearinspiring things by driving out nations from before your people whom you have redeemed from Egypt? (1 Chronicles 17:21)
- But he was merciful, he would cover the error and not bring ruin. And many times he made his anger turn back, and he would not rouse up all his rage. (Psalms 78:38)
- I, I am the One that is wiping out your transgressions for my own sake, and your sins I shall not remember. (Isaiah 43:25)

- For my own sake, for my own sake I shall act, for how could one let oneself be profaned? And to no one else shall I give my own glory. (Isaiah 48:11)
- And I shall have compassion on my holy name, which the house of Israel have profaned among the nations where they have come in. (Ezekiel 36:21)
- And my holy name I shall make known in the midst of my people Israel, and I shall no more let my holy name be profaned, and the nations will have to know that I am Yehowah, the Holy One in Israel. (Ezekiel 39:7)
