

**Ezekiel 21:23** And it has become to them like an untrue divination in their eyes, those who are sworn with oaths to them, and he is calling error to remembrance, in order for them to be caught.

[8] - References:

- For, look! Yehowah is coming forth from his place to call to account the **error** of the inhabitant of the land against him, and the land will certainly expose her bloodshed and will no longer cover over her killed ones. (**Isaiah 26:21**)
- And there is no one **calling** upon your name, no one rousing himself to lay hold on you, for you have concealed your face from us, and you cause us to melt by the power of our **error**. (**Isaiah 64:7**)
- Because **you** men have said; We have concluded a covenant with Death, and with Sheol we have effected a vision, the overflowing flash flood, in case it should pass through, will not come to us, for we have made a lie our refuge and in falsehood we have concealed ourselves. (**Isaiah 28:15**)
- And even against King Nebuchadnezzar he rebelled, who had made him swear by God, and he kept stiffening his neck and hardening his heart so as not to return to Yehowah the God of Israel. (**2 Chronicles 36:13**)
- Furthermore, he took one of the royal seed and concluded a covenant with him and brought him into an oath, and the foremost men of the land he took away. (**Ezekiel 17:13**)
- For on account of the anger of Yehowah it took place in Jerusalem and in Judah, until he had cast them out of his sight. And Zedekiah began to rebel against the king of Babylon. (**2 Kings 24:20**)
- For according to the way earthling man acts he will reward him, and according to the path of man he will cause it to come upon him. (**Job 34:11**)
- Then they seized the king and brought him up to the king of Babylon at Riblah, that they might pronounce a judicial decision upon him. (**2 Kings 25:6**)
