- **Woe to those who are saying that good is bad and bad is good, those who are putting darkness for light and light for darkness, those who are putting bitter for sweet and sweet for bitter! (Isaiah 5:20)**
- **Woe to those wise in their own eyes and discreet even in front of their own faces! (Isaiah 5:21)**
- **Woe to those who are mighty in drinking wine, and to the men with vital energy for mixing intoxicating liquor. (Isaiah 5:22)**
- **Those who are pronouncing the wicked one righteous in consideration of a bribe, and who take away even the righteousness of the righteous one from him! (Isaiah 5:23)**
- **And as for you, O son of man, this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said to the soil of Israel, An end, the end, has come upon the four extremities of the land. (Ezekiel 7:2)**
- **And you must say to the forest of the south; Hear the word of Yehowah. This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Here I am setting a fire ablaze against you, and it must devour in you every still-moist tree and every dry tree. The kindling flame will not be extinguished, and by it all faces must be scorched from the south to the north. (Ezekiel 20:47)**
- **And you must say to them; This is what Yehowah of armies, the God of Israel, has said; Drink and get drunk and puke and fall so that you cannot get up because of the sword that I am sending among you. (Jeremiah 25:27)**
