- **After these things I saw another angel descending from heaven, with great authority, and the earth was lighted up from his glory. (Revelation 18:1)**
- **And he cried out with a strong voice, saying; She has fallen! Babylon the Great has fallen, and she has become a dwelling place of demons and a lurking place of every unclean exhalation and a lurking place of every unclean and hated bird! (Revelation 18:2)**
- **For because of the wine of the anger of her fornication all the nations have fallen victim, and the kings of the earth committed fornication with her, and the traveling merchants of the earth became rich due to the power of her shameless luxury. (Revelation 18:3)**
- **And I heard another voice out of heaven say; Get out of her, my people, if you do not want to share with her in her sins, and if you do not want to receive part of her plagues. (Revelation 18:4)**
- **For her sins have massed together clear up to heaven, and God has called her acts of injustice to mind. (Revelation 18:5)**
- **Render to her even as she herself rendered, and do to her twice as much, yes, twice the number of the things she did, in the cup in which she put a mixture put twice as much of the mixture for her. (Revelation 18:6)**
- **To the extent that she glorified herself and lived in shameless luxury, to that extent give her torment and mourning. For in her heart she keeps saying, I sit a queen, and I am no widow, and I shall never see mourning. (Revelation 18:7)**

- That is why in one day her plagues **will come**, death and mourning and famine, and she **will** be completely burned with fire, because Yehowah God, who judged her, is strong. (**Revelation 18:8**)
- And the kings of the earth who committed fornication with her and lived in shameless luxury **will** weep and beat themselves in grief over her, when they look at the smoke from the burning of her. (**Revelation 18:9**)
- While they stand at a distance because of their fear of her torment and **say**; Too bad, too bad, you great city, Babylon you strong city, because in one hour your judgment has arrived! (**Revelation 18:10**)
- Also, the traveling merchants of the earth are weeping and mourning over her, because there is no one to buy their full stock anymore. (**Revelation 18:11**)
- A full stock of gold and silver and precious stone and pearls and fine linen and purple and silk and scarlet, and everything in scented wood and every sort of ivory object and every sort of object out of most precious wood and of copper and of iron and of marble. (**Revelation 18:12**)
- Also cinnamon and Indian spice and incense and perfumed oil and frankincense and wine and olive oil and fine flour and wheat and cattle and sheep, and horses and coaches and slaves and human souls. (**Revelation 18:13**)
- Yes, the fine fruit that your soul desired has departed from you, and all the dainty things and the gorgeous things have perished from you, and never again **will** people find them. (**Revelation 18:14**)
- The traveling merchants of these things, who became rich from her, **will** stand at a distance because of their fear of her torment and **will** weep and mourn. (**Revelation 18:15**)
- Saying; Too bad, too bad, the great city, clothed with fine linen and purple and scarlet, and richly adorned with gold ornament and precious stone and pearl. (**Revelation 18:16**)
- Because in one hour such great riches have been devastated! And every ship captain and every man that voyages anywhere,

- and sailors and all those who make a living by the sea, stood at a distance (**Revelation 18:17**)
- And cried out as they looked at the smoke from the burning of her and said, What city is like the great city? (**Revelation 18:18**)
 - And they threw dust upon their heads and cried out, weeping and mourning, and said, Too bad, too bad, the great city, in which all those having boats at sea became rich by reason of her costliness, because in one hour she has been devastated! (**Revelation 18:19**)
 - Be glad over her, O heaven, also **you** holy ones and **you** apostles and **you** prophets, because God has judicially exacted punishment for **you** from her! (**Revelation 18:20**)
 - And a strong angel lifted up a stone like a great millstone and hurled it into the sea, saying; Thus with a swift pitch **will** Babylon the great city be hurled **down**, and she **will** never be found again. (**Revelation 18:21**)
 - And the sound of singers who accompany themselves on the harp and of musicians and of flutists and of trumpeters **will** never be heard in you again, and no craftsman of any trade **will** ever be found in you again, and no sound of a millstone **will** ever be heard in you again. (**Revelation 18:22**)
 - And no light of a lamp **will** ever shine in you again, and no voice of a bridegroom and of a bride **will** ever be heard in you again, because your traveling merchants were the top-ranking men of the earth, for by your spiritistic practice all the nations were misled. (**Revelation 18:23**)
 - Yes, in her was found the blood of prophets and of holy ones and of all those who have been slaughtered on the earth. (**Revelation 18:24**)
 - At length it occurred in the twelfth year, in the tenth month, on the fifth day of the month of our exile, that there came to me the escaped one from Jerusalem, saying; The city has been struck down! (**Ezekiel 33:21**)
 - Therefore, when **you** catch sight of the disgusting thing that causes desolation, as spoken of through Daniel the prophet, standing in a holy place, let the reader use discernment. (**Matthew 24:15**)

- Then let those in Judea begin fleeing to the mountains. (**Matthew 24:16**)
- Let the man on the housetop not **come down** to take the goods out of his house. (**Matthew 24:17**)
- And let the man in the field not return to the house to pick up his outer garment. (**Matthew 24:18**)
- Woe to the pregnant women and those suckling a baby in those days! (**Matthew 24:19**)
- Keep praying that **YOUR** flight may not **occur** in wintertime, nor on the Sabbath day. (**Matthew 24:20**)
- For then there **will** be great tribulation such as has not occurred since the world's beginning until now, no, nor **will occur** again. (**Matthew 24:21**)
- In fact, unless those days were cut short, no flesh would be saved, but on **account** of the chosen ones those days **will** be cut short. (**Matthew 24:22**)
- And the people kept saying to me; Will you not tell us **what** these things have to do with us, that you are doing? (**Ezekiel 24:19**)
- That is why this is **what** Yehowah the God of Israel has said; Here I am bringing a calamity upon Jerusalem and Judah, of which if anyone hears both his ears **will** tingle. (**2 Kings 21:12**)
- This is **what** Yehowah has said; Look! A people is coming from the land of the north, and there is a great nation that **will** be awakened from the remotest parts of the earth. (**Jeremiah 6:22**)
- When we got to hear it, then our **hearts** began to **melt**, and no **spirit** has arisen yet in anybody because of **YOU**, for Yehowah **YOUR** God is God in the heavens above and on the earth beneath. (**Joshua 2:11**)

(**Leviticus 26:36**)
