[13] - References:

- And he began drinking of the wine and became intoxicated, and so he **uncovered** himself in the midst of his tent. (**Genesis 9:21**)
- Later Ham the **father** of Canaan saw his father's nakedness and went telling it to his two brothers outside. (**Genesis 9:22**)
- At that Shem and Japheth took a mantle and put it upon both their shoulders and walked in backwards. Thus they covered their father's nakedness, while their faces were turned away, and they did not see their father's nakedness. (**Genesis 9:23**)
- Finally Noah awoke from his wine and got to know what his youngest son had done to him. (**Genesis 9:24**)
- At this he said; Cursed be Canaan. Let him become the lowest slave to his brothers. (**Genesis 9:25**)
- And he added; Blessed be Yehowah, Shem's God, and let Canaan become a slave to him. (**Genesis 9:26**)
- Let God grant ample space to Japheth, and let him reside in the tents of Shem. Let Canaan become a slave to him also. (**Genesis 9:27**)
- And Noah continued to live three hundred and fifty years after the deluge. (**Genesis 9:28**)
- And where a man lies down with a menstruating **woman** and does lay bare her nakedness, he has exposed her source, and she herself has laid bare the source of her blood. So both of them must be cut off from among their people. (**Leviticus 20:18**)
- And the nakedness of your mother's sister and of your father's sister you must not lay bare, because it is his blood relation that one has exposed. They should answer for their error. (**Leviticus 20:19**)

- The nakedness of your **father** and the nakedness of your mother you must not lay bare. She is your mother. You must not lay bare her nakedness. (**Leviticus 18:7**)
- And a man who lies down with his father's wife has laid bare the nakedness of his **father**. Both of them should be put to death without fail. Their own blood is upon them. (**Leviticus 20:11**)
- Cursed is the one who lies down with his father's wife, because he has **uncovered** the skirt of his father. And all the people must say; Amen! (**Deuteronomy 27:20**)
- Actually fornication is reported among **you**, and such fornication as is not even among the nations, that a wife a certain man has of his **father**. (**1 Corinthians 5:1**)
- And you must not come near a **woman** during the **menstruation** of her impurity to lay her nakedness bare. (**Leviticus 18:19**)
- Later Ham the **father** of Canaan saw his father's nakedness and went telling it to his two brothers outside. (**Genesis 9:22**)
- And both the daughters of Lot became pregnant from their **father**. (**Genesis 19:36**)
- Then she said to her **father**; Do not let anger gleam in the eyes of my lord, because I am not able to get up before you, for the customary thing with women is upon me. So he searched on carefully, but did not find the teraphim. (**Genesis 31:35**)
- And in case a **woman** is having a running discharge, and her running discharge in her flesh proves to be blood, she should continue seven days in her menstrual impurity, and anyone touching her will be **unclean** until the evening. (**Leviticus 15:19**)
- And where a man lies down with a menstruating **woman** and does lay bare her nakedness, he has exposed her source, and she herself has laid bare the source of her blood. So both of them must be cut off from among their people. (**Leviticus 20:18**)
- Woe to the one giving his companions something to drink, attaching to it your rage and anger, in order to make them drunk, for the purpose of looking upon their parts of shame. (**Habakkuk 2:15**)
