[7] - References:

- At this Judah **said** to his brothers; What profit would there be in case we killed our brother and did cover over his blood? (**Genesis 37:26**)
- Come and let us sell him to the Ishmaelites, and do not let our hand be upon him. After all, he is our brother, our flesh. So they listened to their brother. (**Genesis 37:27**)
- Now men, Midianite merchants, went passing by. Hence they drew and lifted up Joseph out of the water-pit and then sold Joseph to the Ishmaelites for twenty silver pieces. Eventually these brought Joseph into Egypt. (**Genesis 37:28**)
- Later Reuben returned to the water-pit and here Joseph was not in the water-pit. Consequently he ripped his garments apart. (**Genesis 37:29**)
- When he returned to his other brothers he exclaimed; The child is gone! And I, where **am** I really to go? (**Genesis 37:30**)
- However, they took Joseph's long garment and slaughtered a male goat and repeatedly dipped the long garment in the blood. (**Genesis 37:31**)
- After that they sent the long striped garment and had it brought to their father and **said**; This is what we found. Examine, please, whether it is your son's long garment or not. (**Genesis 37:32**)
- And he went examining it and exclaimed; It is my son's long garment! A vicious wild beast must **have** devoured him! Joseph is surely torn to pieces! (**Genesis 37:33**)
- With that Jacob ripped his mantles apart and put sackcloth upon his hips and carried on mourning over his son for many days. (**Genesis 37:34**)
- But Yehowah **said**; Judah, too, I shall remove from my sight, just as I **have** removed Israel, and I shall certainly reject this city that

- I have** chosen, even **Jerusalem**, and the house of which I **have said**; My name will continue there. (**2 Kings 23:27**)
- **It was only by the order of Yehowah that it took place against Judah, to remove it from his sight for the sins of Manasseh, according to all that he had done. (2 Kings 24:3)**
 - **As scummy dross you have made all the wicked ones of the earth to cease. Therefore I have loved your reminders. (Psalms 119:119)**
 - **Let there be a removing of scummy dross from the silver, and all of it will come forth refined. (Proverbs 25:4)**
 - **But as for them, they have not come to know the thoughts of Yehowah, and they have not come to understand his counsel, because he will certainly collect them together like a row of newly cut grain to the threshing floor. (Micah 4:12)**
 - **Let both grow together until the harvest, and in the harvest season I will tell the reapers, First collect the weeds and bind them in bundles to burn them up, then go to gathering the wheat into my storehouse. (Matthew 13:30)**
