

Ezekiel 22:3

And you must say, This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; O city that is shedding blood in her midst till her time comes, and that has made dungy idols within herself in order to become unclean.

[12] - References:

- Do **you** not know that **you** people are God's temple, and that the spirit of God dwells in **you**? (**1 Corinthians 3:16**)
- If anyone destroys the temple of God, God will destroy him, for the temple of God is holy, which temple **you** people are. (**1 Corinthians 3:17**)
- And I went on to **say** to them; Throw away, each one of **you**, the disgusting things of his eyes, and with the **dungy idols** of Egypt do not defile yourselves. I am Yehowah **YOUR** God. (**Ezekiel 20:7**)
- But **you**, do not **you** be called Rabbi, for one is **YOUR** teacher, whereas all **you** are brothers. (**Matthew 23:8**)
- We, therefore, are under obligation to receive such persons hospitably, that we may **become** fellow workers in the truth. (**3 John 1:8**)
- However, there also came to be false prophets among the people, as there will also be false teachers among **you**. These very ones will quietly bring in destructive sects and will disown even the owner that bought them, bringing speedy destruction upon themselves. (**2 Peter 2:1**)
- But Jesus, calling them to him, **said**; **You** know that the rulers of the nations lord it over them and the great men wield authority over them. (**Matthew 20:25**)
- This is not the way among **you**, but whoever wants to **become** great among **you** must be **YOUR** minister. (**Matthew 20:26**)
- And whoever wants to be first among **you** must be **YOUR** slave. (**Matthew 20:27**)
- Just as the Son of man came, not to be ministered to, but to minister and to give his soul a ransom in exchange for many. (**Matthew 20:28**)

- And they will no more teach each one his companion and each one his brother, saying; **Know** Yehowah! For they will all of them know me, from the least one of them even to the greatest one of them, is the utterance of Yehowah. For I shall forgive their error, and their sin I shall remember no more. (**Jeremiah 31:34**)
- Therefore this is **what** the **Sovereign Lord** Yehowah **has said**; Woe to the **city** of deeds of bloodshed, the widemouthed cooking pot, the rust of which is in it, and the very rust of which **has** not gone forth from it! Piece by piece of it, bring it out, no lot must be cast over it. (**Ezekiel 24:6**)
- For I myself, Yehowah, shall speak **what** word I shall speak, and it will be done. There will be no postponement anymore, for in **YOUR** days, O rebellious house, I shall speak a word and certainly do it, is the utterance of the **Sovereign Lord** Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 12:25**)
- Also, with covetousness they will exploit **you** with counterfeit words. But as for them, the judgment from of old is not moving slowly, and the destruction of them is not slumbering. (**2 Peter 2:3**)
- For the reason that Manasseh the king of Judah **has** done these detestable things, he **has** acted more wickedly than all that the Amorites did that were prior to him, and he proceeded to make even Judah sin with his **dungy idols**. (**2 Kings 21:11**)
- And also the spirit mediums and the professional foretellers of events and the teraphim and the **dungy idols** and all the disgusting things that had appeared in the land of Judah and in Jerusalem Josiah cleared out, in **order** that he might actually carry out the words of the Law that were written in the book that Hilkiah the priest had found at the house of Yehowah. (**2 Kings 23:24**)
