Dutright slanderers<sup>1</sup> have proved to be in you, for the purpose of shedding blood, and on the mountains they have eaten in you. Loose conduct they have carried on in the midst of you.

- There are six things that Yehowah does hate, yes, seven are things detestable to his soul. (Proverbs 6:16)
- Lofty eyes, a false tongue, and hands that are shedding innocent blood. (Proverbs 6:17)
- A heart fabricating hurtful schemes, feet that are in a hurry to run to badness. (Proverbs 6:18)
- A false witness that launches forth lies, and anyone sending forth contentions among brothers. (Proverbs 6:19)
- Certainly, then, shall not God cause justice to be done for his chosen ones who cry out to him day and night, even though he is long-suffering toward them? (Luke 18:7)
- For Yehowah is a lover of justice, and he will not leave his loyal ones. To time indefinite they will certainly be guarded, but as for the offspring of the wicked ones, they will indeed be cut off. (Psalms 37:28)
- Her owner is someone known in the gates, when he sits down with the older men of the land. (Proverbs 31:23)
- At this Yehowah said to me; Out of the north the calamity will be loosened against all the inhabitants of the land. (Jeremiah 1:14)
- For, here I am calling for all the families of the kingdoms of the north, is the utterance of Yehowah, and they will certainly come and place each one his throne at the entrance of the gates of Jerusalem, and against all her walls round about and against all the cities of Judah. (Jeremiah 1:15)
- And I will speak with them my judgments over all their badness, in that they have left me and they keep making sacrificial smoke

to other gods and bowing down to the works of their own hands. (Jeremiah 1:16)

- You must not take up an untrue report. Do not cooperate with a wicked one by becoming a witness who schemes violence. (Exodus 23:1)
- You must not go around among your people for the sake of slandering. You must not stand up against your fellow's blood. I am Yehowah. (Leviticus 19:16)
- On the mountains he did not eat and his eyes he did not raise to the dungy idols of the house of Israel, and his companion's wife he did not defile and to a woman in her impurity he would not go near. (Ezekiel 18:6)
- Hence I grasped my concubine and cut her up and sent her into every field of Israel's inheritance, because they had carried on loose conduct and disgraceful folly in Israel. (Judges 20:6)
- In whose hands there is loose conduct, and whose right hand is full of bribery. (Psalms 26:10)
- To the stupid one the carrying on of loose conduct is like sport, but wisdom is for the man of discernment. (Proverbs 10:23)
- Your acts of adultery and your neighings, your loose conduct in prostitution. Upon the hills, in the field, I have seen your disgusting things. Woe to you, O Jerusalem! You cannot be clean, after how much longer? (Jeremiah 13:27)
- And, look! I shall certainly stretch out my hand against you and I shall diminish your allowance and give you to the soulful desire of the women hating you, the daughters of the Philistines, the women humiliated on account of your way as regards loose conduct. (Ezekiel 16:27)
- And he delivered righteous Lot, who was greatly distressed by the indulgence of the law-defying people in loose conduct. (2 Peter 2:7)
- And he proceeded to inquire of Yehowah for him, and provisions he gave him, and the sword of Goliath the Philistine he gave him. (1 Samuel 22:10)

- Guard yourselves each one against his own companion, and put your trust in no brother at all. For even every brother would positively supplant, and every companion himself would walk around as a mere slanderer. (Jeremiah 9:4)
- When someone righteous turns back from his righteousness and he actually does injustice and dies on account of them, for his injustice that he has done he will die. (Ezekiel 18:26)
- For the reason that they rejected my own judicial decisions, and as regards my statutes, they did not walk in them, and my Sabbaths they profaned, because it was after their dungy idols that their heart was going. (Ezekiel 20:16)
- And I shall certainly cause loose conduct to cease out of the land, and all the women will have to let themselves be corrected, so that they will not do according to YOUR loose conduct. (Ezekiel 23:48)
- There was loose conduct in your uncleanness. For that reason I had to cleanse you, but you did not become clean from your uncleanness. You will become clean no more until I cause my rage to come to its rest in your case. (Ezekiel 24:13)
- And as in the lying in wait for a man, the association of priests are marauding bands. By the wayside they commit murder at Shechem, because they have carried on nothing but loose conduct. (Hosea 6:9)
- Having no natural affection, not open to any agreement, slanderers, without self-control, fierce, without love of goodness. (2 Timothy 3:3)
