**[8] - References:**

- **The prophets themselves actually prophesy in falsehood, and as for the priests, they go subduing according to their powers. And my own people have loved it that way, and what will **YOU** men do in the finale of it? (**Jeremiah 5:31**)**
- **Saying; Do not **YOU** men touch my anointed ones, and to my prophets do nothing bad. (**Psalms 105:15**)**
- **But whoever has this world's means for supporting life and beholds his brother having need and yet shuts the door of his tender compassions upon him, in what way does the love of God remain in him? (**1 John 3:17**)**
- **Little children, let us love, neither in word nor with the tongue, but in deed and truth. (**1 John 3:18**)**
- **On this account I say to **YOU**; Stop being anxious about **YOUR** souls as to what **YOU** will eat or what **YOU** will drink, or about **YOUR** bodies as to what **YOU** will wear. Does not the soul mean more than food and the body than clothing? (**Matthew 6:25**)**
- **Observe intently the birds of heaven, because they do not sow seed or reap or gather into storehouses, still **YOUR** heavenly Father feeds them. Are **YOU** not worth more than they are? (**Matthew 6:26**)**
- **Who of **YOU** by being anxious can add one cubit to his life span? (**Matthew 6:27**)**
- **With that he spoke an illustration to them, saying; The land of a certain rich man produced well. (**Luke 12:16**)**
- **Consequently he began reasoning within himself, saying, What shall I do, now that I have nowhere to gather my crops? (**Luke 12:17**)**

- **So he said, I will do this; I will tear down my storehouses and build bigger ones, and there I will gather all my grain and all my good things. (Luke 12:18)**
- **And I will say to my soul; Soul, you have many good things laid up for many years, take your ease, eat, drink, enjoy yourself. (Luke 12:19)**
- **But God said to him; Unreasonable one, this night they are demanding your soul from you. Who, then, is to have the things you stored up? (Luke 12:20)**
- **So it goes with the man that lays up treasure for himself but is not rich toward God. (Luke 12:21)**
- **My lips will speak no unrighteousness and my own tongue will mutter no deceit! (Job 27:4)**
- **It is unthinkable on my part that I should declare **you** men righteous! Until I expire I shall not take away my integrity from myself! (Job 27:5)**
- **On my justness I have laid hold, and I shall not let it go, my heart will not taunt me for any of my days. (Job 27:6)**
- **And you went prostituting yourself to the sons of Egypt, your neighbors great of flesh, and you continued making your prostitution abound in order to offend me. (Ezekiel 16:26)**
