

Ezekiel 23:25 And I will express my ardor against you, and they must take action against you in rage. Your nose and your ears they will remove, and the remainder of you will fall even by the sword. Your sons and your daughters they themselves will take, and the fire will devour the remainder of you.

- For this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Here I am bringing **against** Tyre Nebuchadrezzar the king of Babylon from the north, a king of kings, with horses and war chariots and cavalymen and a congregation, **even** a multitudinous people. (**Ezekiel 26:7**)
- Except it be that one **must** bow down under the prisoners and that people keep falling under those who have been killed? In view of all this his anger has not turned back, but his hand is stretched out still. (**Isaiah 10:4**)
- Yehowah **will** not want to forgive him, but then Yehowah's anger and his **ardor will** smoke **against** that man, and all the oath written in this book **will** certainly settle down on him, and Yehowah **will** indeed wipe out his name from under the heavens. (**Deuteronomy 29:20**)
- And in my **ardor**, in the **fire** of my fury, I shall have to speak. Surely in that day a great quaking **will** occur in the soil of Israel. (**Ezekiel 38:19**)
- Neither their silver nor their gold **will** be able to deliver them in the day of Yehowah's fury, but by the **fire** of his zeal the whole earth **will** be devoured, because he **will** make an extermination, indeed a terrible one, of all the inhabitants of the earth. (**Zephaniah 1:18**)
- And I **will** judge you with the judgments of adulteresses and women shedding blood, and I **will** give you the blood of **rage** and jealousy. (**Ezekiel 16:38**)
- And their names were Oholah the older one and Oholibah her sister, and they came to be mine and began to give birth to **sons** and **daughters**. And as for their names, Oholah is Samaria, and Oholibah is Jerusalem. (**Ezekiel 23:4**)

- Now this Hagar means Sinai, a mountain in Arabia, and she corresponds with the Jerusalem today, for she is in slavery with her children. (**Galatians 4:25**)
- And to her **sons** I shall not show mercy, for they are the **sons** of fornication. (**Hosea 2:4**)
- And I have set my face **against** them. Out of the **fire** they have gone forth, but the **fire** itself **will devour** them. And **you** people **will** have to know that I am Yehowah, when I direct my face **against** them. (**Ezekiel 15:7**)
- And you **must** say to the forest of the south; Hear the word of Yehowah. This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Here I am setting a **fire** ablaze **against** you, and it **must devour** in you every still-moist tree and every dry tree. The kindling flame **will** not be extinguished, and by it all faces **must** be scorched from the south to the north. (**Ezekiel 20:47**)
- That is why in one day her plagues **will** come, death and mourning and famine, and she **will** be completely burned with **fire**, because Yehowah God, who judged her, is strong. (**Revelation 18:8**)
- Say to the house of Israel; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said, Here I am profaning my sanctuary, the pride of **YOUR** strength, the thing desirable to **YOUR** eyes and the object of **YOUR** soul's compassion, and **YOUR sons** and **YOUR daughters** whom **YOU** people have left behind, by the **sword** they **will fall**. (**Ezekiel 24:21**)
- For her burial places have been put in the innermost parts of a pit, and her congregation proves to be round about her grave, all of them slain, falling by the **sword**, because they had caused terror in the land of those alive. (**Ezekiel 32:23**)
