

**Ezekiel 23:27** And I shall actually cause your loose conduct to cease from you, and your prostitution carried from the land of Egypt, and you will not raise your eyes to them, and Egypt you will remember no more.

- And I went on to say to them; Throw away, each one of **you**, the disgusting things of his **eyes**, and with the dungy idols of **Egypt** do not defile yourselves. I am Yehowah **YOUR** God. (**Ezekiel 20:7**)
- And they must burn your houses with fire and execute in you acts of judgment before the **eyes** of many women, and I **will** cause you to **cease** from being a prostitute, and also no more hire **will** you give. (**Ezekiel 16:41**)
- And I **will** scatter you among the nations and disperse you among the **lands**, and I **will** destroy your uncleanness out of you. (**Ezekiel 22:15**)
- Therefore by this means the error of Jacob **will** be atoned for, and this is all the fruit when he takes away his sin, when he makes all the stones of the altar like chalkstones that have been pulverized, so that the sacred poles and the incense stands **will** not rise up. (**Isaiah 27:9**)
- And it must occur in that day, is the utterance of Yehowah of armies, that I shall cut off the names of the idols out of the **land**, and they **will** no more be remembered, and also the prophets and the spirit of uncleanness I shall cause to pass out of the **land**. (**Zechariah 13:2**)
- And they began to prostitute themselves in **Egypt**. In their youth they committed **prostitution**. There their breasts were squeezed, and there they pressed the bosoms of their virginity. (**Ezekiel 23:3**)
- And she kept multiplying her acts of **prostitution** to the point of calling to mind the days of her youth, when she prostituted herself in the **land** of **Egypt**. (**Ezekiel 23:19**)
- And I shall certainly cause **loose conduct** to **cease** out of the **land**, and all the women **will** have to let themselves be corrected, so that they **will** not do according to **YOUR loose conduct**. (**Ezekiel 23:48**)
