

**Ezekiel 23:32** **This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; The cup of your sister you will drink, the deep and wide one. You will become an object of laughter and derision, the cup containing much.**

[9] - References:

- That you must raise up this proverbial saying against the king of Babylon and say; How **has** the one driving others to work come to a stop, the oppression come to a stop! (**Isaiah 14:4**)
- Yehowah **has** broken the rod of the wicked ones, the staff of the ruling ones. (**Isaiah 14:5**)
- There have been transgressing and a denying of Yehowah, and there was a moving back from our God, a speaking of oppression and revolt, a conceiving and a muttering of words of falsehood from the very heart. (**Isaiah 59:13**)
- And justice was forced to move back, and righteousness itself kept standing simply far off. For truth **has** stumbled even in the public square, and what is straightforward is unable to enter. (**Isaiah 59:14**)
- And the truth proves to be missing, and anyone turning away from badness is being despoiled. And Yehowah got to see, and it was bad in his eyes that there was no justice. (**Isaiah 59:15**)
- And when he saw that there was no man, he began to show himself astonished that there was no one interposing. And his arm proceeded to save for him, and his own righteousness was the thing that supported him. (**Isaiah 59:16**)
- For this is what Yehowah the God of Israel **said** to me; Take this **cup** of the wine of rage out of my hand, and you must make all the nations to whom I am sending you **drink** it. (**Jeremiah 25:15**)
- And they must **drink** and shake back and forth and act like crazed men because of the sword that I am sending among them. (**Jeremiah 25:16**)
- And I proceeded to take the **cup** out of the hand of Yehowah and to make all the nations **drink** to whom Yehowah had sent me. (**Jeremiah 25:17**)

- **Namely, Jerusalem and the cities of Judah and her kings, her princes, to make them a devastated place, an **object** of astonishment, something to whistle at and a malediction, just as at this day. (**Jeremiah 25:18**)**
- **Rouse yourself, rouse yourself, rise up, O Jerusalem, you who have drunk at the hand of Yehowah his **cup** of rage. The goblet, the **cup** causing reeling, you have drunk, you have drained out. (**Isaiah 51:17**)**
- **And you must **become** an **object** of astonishment, a proverbial saying and a taunt among all the peoples to whom Yehowah **will** lead you away. (**Deuteronomy 28:37**)**
- **I **will** also cut Israel off from upon the surface of the ground that I have given to them, and the house that I have sanctified to my name I shall throw away from before me, and Israel **will** indeed **become** a proverbial saying and a taunt among all the peoples. (**1 Kings 9:7**)**
- **At you all those passing along on the road have clapped their hands. They have whistled and kept wagging their head at the daughter of Jerusalem, saying; Is this the city of which they used to say, It is the perfection of prettiness, an exultation for all the earth? (**Lamentations 2:15**)**
- **The lands nearby and those far away from you **will** jeer you, O you unclean in name, abounding in confusion. (**Ezekiel 22:5**)**
- **By your blood that you have shed you have **become** guilty, and by your dungy idols that you have made you have **become** unclean. And you bring your days near, and you **will** come to your years. That is why I must make you an **object** of reproach to the nations and of jeering to all the lands. (**Ezekiel 22:4**)**
