- Consequently I entreat **you** by the compassions of God, brothers, to present **your** bodies a sacrifice living, holy, acceptable to God, a sacred service with **your** power of reason. (**Romans 12:1**)
- And quit being fashioned after this system of things, but be transformed by making **your** mind over, that **you** may prove to yourselves the good and acceptable and perfect will of God. (**Romans 12:2**)
- My little children, I am writing **you** these things that **you** may not commit a sin. And yet, if anyone does commit a sin, we **have** a helper with the Father, Jesus Christ, a righteous one. (**1 John 2:1**)
- And he is a propitiatory sacrifice for our sins, yet not for ours only but also for the whole world's. (**1 John 2:2**)
- And by this we **have** the knowledge that we **have** come to know him, namely, if we continue observing his commandments. (**1 John 2:3**)
- Woe to those who are saying that good is bad and bad is good, those who are putting darkness for light and light for darkness, those who are putting bitter for sweet and sweet for bitter! (**Isaiah 5:20**)
- Woe to those wise in their own eyes and discreet even in front of their own faces! (**Isaiah 5:21**)
- Woe to those who are mighty in drinking wine, and to the men with vital energy for mixing intoxicating liquor. (**Isaiah 5:22**)
- Those who are pronouncing the wicked one righteous in consideration of a bribe, and who take away even the righteousness of the righteous one from him! (**Isaiah 5:23**)
- And they went putting their disgusting things in the house upon which my own name has been called, in order to defile it. (**Jeremiah 32:34**)

- **Therefore as I am alive, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah, surely for the reason that it was my **sanctuary** that you **defiled** with all your disgusting things and with all your detestable things, I myself also am the One that will diminish you and my eye will not feel sorry and I myself also will not show compassion. (Ezekiel 5:11)**
- **And he proceeded to say to me; Son of man, please, raise your eyes in the direction of the north. So I raised my eyes in the direction of the north, and, look! To the north of the gate of the altar there was this symbol of jealousy in the entranceway. (Ezekiel 8:5)**
- **And he built altars in the house of Yehowah, respecting which Yehowah had said; In Jerusalem I shall put my name. (2 Kings 21:4)**
- **So I began to find fault with the nobles of Judah and say to them; What is this bad thing that **you** are doing, even profaning the Sabbath **day**? (Nehemiah 13:17)**
- **My holy places you **have** despised, and my **Sabbaths** you **have profaned**. (Ezekiel 22:8)**
