them, the choicest sons of Assyria all of them, and with all those after whom she lusted, with their dungy idols, she defiled herself.

- With whom the kings of the earth committed fornication, whereas those who inhabit the earth were made drunk with the wine of her fornication. (Revelation 17:2)
- And he carried me away in the power of the spirit into a wilderness. And I caught sight of a woman sitting upon a scarlet-colored wild beast that was full of blasphemous names and that had seven heads and ten horns. (Revelation 17:3)
- And the woman was arrayed in purple and scarlet, and was adorned with gold and precious stone and pearls and had in her hand a golden cup that was full of disgusting things and the unclean things of her fornication. (Revelation 17:4)
- And upon her forehead was written a name, a mystery. Babylon the Great, the mother of the harlots and of the disgusting things of the earth. (Revelation 17:5)
- And I saw that the woman was drunk with the blood of the holy ones and with the blood of the witnesses of Jesus. Well, on catching sight of her I wondered with great wonderment. (Revelation 17:6)
- For her sins have massed together clear up to heaven, and God has called her acts of injustice to mind. (Revelation 18:5)
- Render to her even as she herself rendered, and do to her twice as much, yes, twice the number of the things she did, in the cup in which she put a mixture put twice as much of the mixture for her. (Revelation 18:6)
- To the extent that she glorified herself and lived in shameless luxury, to that extent give her torment and mourning. For in her

- heart she keeps saying, I sit a queen, and I am no widow, and I shall never see mourning. (Revelation 18:7)
- That is why in one day her plagues will come, death and mourning and famine, and she will be completely burned with fire, because Yehowah God, who judged her, is strong. (Revelation 18:8)
- And they got to be unclean by their works and kept having immoral intercourse by their dealings. (Psalms 106:39)
- I personally have known Ephraim, and Israel itself has not been hidden from me. For now, O Ephraim, you have treated women like harlots, Israel has defiled itself. (Hosea 5:3)
- In the house of Israel I have seen a horrible thing. There there is fornication on the part of Ephraim. Israel has defiled itself. (Hosea 6:10)
