Ezekiel 24:17... Sigh without words. For the dead ones no mourning should you make. Your headdress bind on yourself, and your sandals you should put upon your feet. And you should not cover over the mustache, and the bread of men you should not eat.

- Jesus said to him; Keep following me, and let the dead bury their dead. (Matthew 8:22)
- Indeed, as the body without spirit is dead, so also faith without works is dead. (James 2:26)
- For this is what Yehowah has said, Do not enter into the house of a mourners' feast, and do not go to bewail and do not sympathize with them. For I have taken away my peace from this people, is the utterance of Yehowah, even loving-kindness and mercies. (Jeremiah 16:5)
- Subsequently Moses said to Aaron and to Eleazar and Ithamar his other sons; Do not let your heads go un-groomed, and you must not tear your garments, that you may not die and that he may not become indignant against all the assembly, but your brothers of the whole house of Israel will do the weeping over the burning, which Yehowah has made burn. (Leviticus 10:6)
- And David was going up by the ascent of the Olives, weeping as he went up, with his head covered, and he was walking barefoot, and all the people that were with him covered each one his head, and they went up weeping as they went up. (2 Samuel 15:30)
- And the visionaries will have to be ashamed, and the diviners will certainly be disappointed. And they will have to cover over the mustache, all of them, for there is no answer from God. (Micah 3:7)
- And they will not deal out to them any bread on account of mourning to comfort someone over the dead, neither will they give them the cup of consolation to drink on account of one's father and on account of one's mother. (Jeremiah 16:7)

- As for the leprous one in whom the plague is, his garments should be torn, and his head should become un-groomed, and he should cover over the mustache and call out; Unclean, unclean! (Leviticus 13:45)
- Later all the people came to give David bread for consolation while it was yet that day, but David swore, saying; So may God do to me and so may he add to it, if before the sun sets I shall taste bread or anything at all! (2 Samuel 3:35)
- And you will have to do just as I have done. Mustaches you will not cover over, and the bread of men you will not eat. (Ezekiel 24:22)
