Upon the shining, bare surface of a crag she placed it. She did not pour it out upon the earth, in order to cover it over with dust.

- Do you not know that you people are God's temple, and that the spirit of God dwells in you? (1 Corinthians 3:16)

- As for any man of the sons of Israel or some alien resident who is residing as an alien in your midst who in hunting catches a wild beast or a fowl that may be eaten, he must in that case pour its blood out and cover it with dust. (Leviticus 17:13)
- Only the blood you must not eat. On the earth you should pour it out as water. (Deuteronomy 12:16)
- For, look! Yehowah is coming forth from his place to call to account the error of the inhabitant of the land against him, and the land will certainly expose her bloodshed and will no longer cover over her killed ones. (Isaiah 26:21)
