

Ezekiel 25:16 **Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Here I am stretching out my hand against the Philistines, and I will cut off the Cherethites and destroy the rest of the seacoast.**

[13] - References:

- Do not avenge yourselves, beloved, but yield place to the wrath, for it is written: Vengeance is mine, I **will** repay, says Yehowah. (**Romans 12:19**)
- You must not take vengeance nor have a grudge **against** the sons of your people, and you must love your fellow as yourself. I **am** Yehowah. (**Leviticus 19:18**)
- Vengeance is mine, and retribution. At the appointed time their foot **will** move unsteadily, for the day of their disaster is near, and the events in readiness for them do make haste. (**Deuteronomy 32:35**)
- If I do indeed sharpen my glittering sword, and my **hand** takes hold on judgment, I **will** pay back vengeance to my adversaries and render retribution to those who intensely hate me. (**Deuteronomy 32:41**)
- For Yehowah **has** a day of vengeance, a year of retributions for the legal case over Zion. (**Isaiah 34:8**)
- Say to those who are anxious at heart; Be strong. Do not be afraid. Look! **YOUR** own God **will** come with vengeance itself, God even with a repayment. He himself **will** come and save **you** people. (**Isaiah 35:4**)
- For, as regards Gaza, an abandoned city is what she **will** become, and Ashkelon is to be a desolate waste. As regards Ashdod, at high noon they **will** drive her **out**, and as regards Ekron, she **will** be uprooted. (**Zephaniah 2:4**)
- Woe to those inhabiting the region of the sea, the nation of **Cherethites**! The word of Yehowah is **against you** people. O Canaan, the land of the **Philistines**, I **will** also **destroy** you, so that there **will** be no inhabitant. (**Zephaniah 2:5**)

- We were the ones that made a raid on the south of the **Cherethites** and upon that which belongs to Judah and upon the south of Caleb, and Ziklag we burned with fire. (**1 Samuel 30:14**)
- On account of the day that is coming to despoil all the **Philistines**, to **cut** off from Tyre and from Sidon every survivor that was helping. For Yehowah is despoiling the **Philistines**, who are the remaining ones from the island of Caphtor. (**Jeremiah 47:4**)
- And the firstborn ones of the lowly ones **will** certainly feed, and in security the poor ones themselves **will** lie down. And with famine I **will** put your root to death, and what remains over of you **will** be killed. (**Isaiah 14:30**)
- How can it stay quiet, when Yehowah himself **has** given a command to it? It is for Ashkelon and for the coast of the sea. There is where he **has** designated it to be. (**Jeremiah 47:7**)
- And I **will cut** off the inhabitant from Ashdod, and the holder of the scepter from Ashkelon, and I **will** turn my **hand** back upon Ekron, and the remaining ones of the **Philistines** must perish, the **Sovereign Lord** Yehowah **has** said. (**Amos 1:8**)
- For, as regards Gaza, an abandoned city is what she **will** become, and Ashkelon is to be a desolate waste. As regards Ashdod, at high noon they **will** drive her **out**, and as regards Ekron, she **will** be uprooted. (**Zephaniah 2:4**)
