Ezekiel 25:16... Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Here I am stretching out my hand against the Philistines, and I will cut off the Cherethites and destroy the rest of the seacoast.

- Do not avenge yourselves, beloved, but yield place to the wrath, for it is written: Vengeance is mine, I will repay, says Yehowah. (Romans 12:19)
- You must not take vengeance nor have a grudge against the sons of your people, and you must love your fellow as yourself. I am Yehowah. (Leviticus 19:18)
- Vengeance is mine, and retribution. At the appointed time their foot will move unsteadily, for the day of their disaster is near, and the events in readiness for them do make haste.
