Ezekiel 25:17... And I will execute in them great acts of vengeance, with raging reproofs, and they will have to know that I am Yehowah when I bring my vengeance on them.

- You ought to uncover your nakedness. Also, your reproach ought to be seen. Vengeance is what I shall take, and I shall not meet any man kindly. (Isaiah 47:3)
- There is the sound of those fleeing and those escaping from the land of Babylon to tell out in Zion the vengeance of Yehowah our God, the vengeance for his temple. (Jeremiah 50:28)
- And you must become a reproach and an object of reviling words, a warning example and a horror to the nations that are all around you, when I do in you acts of judgment in anger and in rage and in raging reproofs. I myself, Yehowah, have spoken. (Ezekiel 5:15)
- Yehowah is a God exacting exclusive devotion and taking vengeance, Yehowah is taking vengeance and is disposed to rage. Yehowah is taking vengeance against his adversaries, and he is resentful toward his enemies. (Nahum 1:2)
- Yehowah is known by the judgment that he has executed. By the activity of his own hands the wicked one has been ensnared. (Psalms 9:16)
- This is what Yehowah has said; By this you will know that I am Yehowah. Here I am striking with the rod that is in my hand upon the water that is in the Nile River, and it will certainly turn into blood. (Exodus 7:17)
- The righteous one will rejoice because he has beheld the vengeance. His steps he will bathe in the blood of the wicked one. (Psalms 58:10)
- And I shall certainly magnify myself and sanctify myself and make myself known before the eyes of many nations, and they will have to know that I am Yehowah. (Ezekiel 38:23)
- To execute judgment against all, and to convict all the ungodly concerning all their ungodly deeds that they did in an ungodly

way, and concerning all the shocking things that ungodly sinners spoke against him. (Jude 1:15)
