- And they must take action against you in hatred and take away all your product of toil and leave you naked and nude, and the nakedness of your acts of fornication and your loose conduct and your acts of prostitution must be uncovered. (**Ezekiel 23:29**)
- There **will** be a doing of these things to you because of your going like a prostitute after the nations, on account of the fact that you defiled yourself with their dungy idols. (**Ezekiel 23:30**)
- In the way of your sister you **have** walked, and I shall **have** to give her cup into your hand. (**Ezekiel 23:31**)
- And Joab continued to fight against **Rabbah** of the **sons of Ammon** and got to capture the city of the kingdom. (**2 Samuel 12:26**)
- A way you should set for the sword to enter against **Rabbah** of the **sons of Ammon**, and one against Judah, against Jerusalem fortified. (**Ezekiel 21:20**)
- The cities of Aroer that **have** been left behind become mere places for droves, where they actually lie down, with no one to **make** them tremble. (**Isaiah 17:2**)
- For the dwelling tower itself has been forsaken, the very hubbub of the city has been abandoned, Ophel and the watchtower themselves **have** become bare fields, for time indefinite the exultation of zebras, the **pasture** of droves. (**Isaiah 32:14**)
- And in the midst of her, droves **will** certainly lie stretched out, all the wild animals of a nation. Both pelican and porcupine **will** spend the night right among her pillar capitals. A voice **will** keep singing in the window. There **will** be devastation at the threshold, for he **will** certainly lay bare the very wainscoting. (**Zephaniah 2:14**)
- And now, O Yehowah our God, save us out of his hand, that all the kingdoms of the earth may **know** that you, O Yehowah, are God alone. (**Isaiah 37:20**)

- And her dependent towns that are in the field, by the sword they **will** be killed, and **people will have to know** that I **am** Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 26:6**)
- And I **will** pour out upon you my denunciation. With the fire of my fury I shall blow upon you, and I **will** give you into the hand of men who are unreasoning, the craftsmen of ruination. (**Ezekiel 21:31**)
- And Ezekiel has become for **you** a portent. In accord with all that he has done, **you will** do. When it comes, **you will** also **have to know** that I **am** the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 24:24**)
- And the region of the sea must become **pasture grounds**, with wells for shepherds and stone pens for sheep. (**Zephaniah 2:6**)
