Ezekiel 25:8" This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said, For the reason that Moab and Seir have said; Look! The house of Judah is like all the other nations.

- A pronouncement! The word of Yehowah concerning Israel by means of Malachi. (Malachi 1:1)
- I have loved you people, Yehowah has said. And you have said; In what way have you loved us? Was not Esau the brother of Jacob? Is the utterance of Yehowah. But I loved Jacob. (Malachi 1:2)
- And Esau I have hated, and I finally made his mountains a desolated waste and his inheritance for the jackals of the wilderness. (Malachi 1:3)
- Because Edom keeps saying; We have been shattered, but we shall return and build the devastated places, this is what Yehowah of armies has said, They, for their part, will build, but I, for my part, shall tear down. And people will certainly call them the territory of wickedness and the people whom Yehowah has denounced to time indefinite. (Malachi 1:4)
- And YOUR own eyes will see it, and YOU yourselves will say; May Yehowah be magnified over the territory of Israel. (Malachi 1:5)
- The pronouncement against Moab; Because in the night it has been despoiled, Ar of Moab itself has been silenced. Because in the night it has been despoiled, Kir of Moab itself has been silenced. (Isaiah 15:1)
- For Moab this is what Yehowah of armies, the God of Israel, has said; Woe to Nebo, for she has been despoiled! Kiriathaim has been put to shame, has been captured. The secure height has been put to shame and been put in terror. (Jeremiah 48:1)
- This is what Yehowah has said; On account of three revolts of Moab, and on account of four, I shall not turn it back, on account of his burning the bones of the king of Edom for lime. (Amos 2:1)
- And command the people, saying; You are passing along by the border of Your brothers, the sons of Esau, who are dwelling in

- Seir, and they will be afraid because of YOU, and YOU must be very careful. (Deuteronomy 2:4)
- Is not Calno just like Carchemish? Is not Hamath just like Arpad? Is not Samaria just like Damascus? (Isaiah 10:9)
- In order that Hezekiah may not allure You, saying; Yehowah himself will deliver us. Have the gods of the nations delivered each one his own land out of the hand of the king of Assyria? (Isaiah 36:18)
- Edom and Moab and the sons of Ammon. (Jeremiah 25:21)
- And you must send them to the king of Edom and to the king of Moab and to the king of the sons of Ammon and to the king of Tyre and to the king of Sidon by the hand of the messengers who are coming to Jerusalem to Zedekiah the king of Judah. (Jeremiah 27:3)
- And I will set fire to the wall of Rabbah, and it must devour her dwelling towers, with an alarm signal in the day of battle, with a tempest in the day of storm wind. (Amos 1:14)
- I have heard the reproach by Moab and the abusive words of the sons of Ammon, with which they have reproached my people and kept putting on great airs against their territory. (Zephaniah 2:8)
