

**Ezekiel 26:14** And I will make you a shining, bare surface of a crag. A drying yard for dragnets is what you will become. Never will you be rebuilt, for I myself, Yehowah, have spoken, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah.

- And I saw that the woman was drunk with the blood of the holy ones and with the blood of the witnesses of Jesus. Well, on catching sight of her I wondered with great wonderment. (**Revelation 17:6**)
- Therefore this is **what** the **Sovereign Lord** Yehowah has said; Woe to the city of deeds of bloodshed, the widemouthed cooking pot, the rust of which is in it, and the very rust of which has not gone forth from it! Piece by piece of it, bring it out, no lot must be cast over it. (**Ezekiel 24:6**)
- Woe to the one that is building a city by bloodshed, and that has solidly established a town by unrighteousness! (**Habakkuk 2:12**)
- Look! Is it not from Yehowah of armies that peoples **will** toil on only for the fire, and that national groups **will** tire themselves out merely for nothing? (**Habakkuk 2:13**)
- For the earth **will** be filled with the knowing of the glory of Yehowah as the waters themselves cover over the sea. (**Habakkuk 2:14**)
- And they **will** certainly bring the walls of Tyre to ruin and tear down her towers, and I **will** scrape her dust away from her and **make** her a **shining, bare surface** of a **crag**. (**Ezekiel 26:4**)
