- **And he put out of business the foreign-god priests, whom the kings of Judah had put in that they might **make** sacrificial smoke on the high places in the **cities** of Judah and the surroundings of Jerusalem, and also those making sacrificial smoke to Baal, to the sun and to the moon and to the constellations of the zodiac and to all the army of the heavens. (2 Kings 23:5)**
- **And the high places that were in front of Jerusalem, that were to the right of the Mount of Ruination, that Solomon the king of Israel had built to Ashtoreth the disgusting thing of the Sidonians and to Chemosh the disgusting thing of Moab and to Milcom the detestable thing of the sons of Ammon, the king made unfit for worship. (2 Kings 23:13)**
- **Furthermore, everyone hearing these sayings of mine and not doing them **will** be likened to a foolish man, who built his house upon the sand. (Matthew 7:26)**
- **And the rain poured down and the floods came and the winds blew and struck against that house and it caved in, and its collapse was great. (Matthew 7:27)**
- **Concerning that day and hour nobody knows, neither the angels of the heavens nor the Son, but only the Father. (Matthew 24:36)**
- **For just as the days of Noah were, so the presence of the Son of man **will** be. (Matthew 24:37)**
- **For as they were in those days before the flood, eating and drinking, men marrying and women being given in marriage, until the day that Noah entered into the ark. (Matthew 24:38)**
- **And they took no note until the flood came and swept them all away, so the presence of the Son of man **will** be. (Matthew 24:39)**

- Then two men **will** be in the field, one **will** be taken along and the other be abandoned. (**Matthew 24:40**)
- Two women **will** be grinding at the hand mill, one **will** be taken along and the other be abandoned. (**Matthew 24:41**)
- Keep on the watch, therefore, because **you** do not know on what day **your Lord** is coming. (**Matthew 24:42**)
- Even therefore, look! Yehowah is bringing up against them the mighty and the many **waters** of the River, the king of Assyria and all his glory. And he **will** certainly come up over all his streambeds and go over all his banks (**Isaiah 8:7**)
- Now you **have** been broken by the open sea, in the depths of the **waters**. As for your articles of exchange and all your congregation, in the midst of you they **have** fallen. (**Ezekiel 27:34**)
