[6] - References:

- Sudden **terrors** have been turned upon me, my noble bearing is chased like the wind, and like a cloud my salvation has passed away. (**Job 30:15**)
- The national groups themselves **will make** a din just like the noise of many waters. And He **will** certainly rebuke it, and it must flee far away and be chased like the chaff of the mountains before a wind and like a thistle whirl before a storm wind. (**Isaiah 17:13**)
- At evening time, why, look! There is sudden terror. Before morning, it is no more. This is the share of those pillaging us, and the lot belonging to those plundering us. (**Isaiah 17:14**)
- As for merchants among the peoples, they **will** certainly whistle over you. Sudden **terrors** are **what** you must become, and you **will** be no more to time indefinite. (**Ezekiel 27:36**)
- And just a little while longer, and the wicked one **will** be no more, and you **will** certainly give attention to his place, and he **will** not be. (**Psalms 37:10**)
- And yet he proceeded to pass away, and there he was not, and I kept seeking him, and he was not **found**. (**Psalms 37:36**)
- As for all those knowing you among the peoples, they **will** certainly stare in amazement at you. Sudden **terrors** are **what** you must become, and you **will** be no more to time indefinite. (**Ezekiel 28:19**)
- And a strong angel lifted up a stone like a great millstone and hurled it into the sea, saying; Thus with a swift pitch **will** Babylon the great city be hurled down, and she **will** never be **found** again. (**Revelation 18:21**)
