- Every one that is found **will** be pierced through, and every one that is caught in the sweep **will** fall by the sword. (**Isaiah 13:15**)
- And I **will make** her a possession of porcupines and reedy pools of water, and I **will** sweep her with the broom of annihilation, is the utterance of Yehowah of armies. (**Isaiah 14:23**)
- And they took no note until the flood came and swept them all **away**, so the presence of the Son of man **will** be. (**Matthew 24:39**)
- His hand he has stretched out over the sea, he has caused kingdoms to be agitated. Yehowah himself has given a command against Phoenicia, to annihilate her strongholds. (**Isaiah 23:11**)
- And I **will** send a fire onto the wall of **Tyre**, and it must devour her dwelling towers. (**Amos 1:10**)
- Look! Yehowah himself **will** dispossess her, and into the sea he **will certainly** strike **down** her military force, and in the fire she herself **will** be devoured. (**Zechariah 9:4**)
