[8] - References:

- And one of the seven angels that had the seven bowls came and spoke with me, saying; Come, I **will** show you the judgment upon the great harlot who sits on many waters. (**Revelation 17:1**)
- And upon her forehead was written a name, a mystery. Babylon the Great, the mother of the harlots and of the disgusting things of the earth. (**Revelation 17:5**)
- And I saw that the woman was drunk with the blood of the holy ones and with the blood of the witnesses of Jesus. Well, on catching sight of her I wondered with great wonderment. (**Revelation 17:6**)
- And the ten horns that you saw, and the wild beast, these **will** hate the harlot and **will make** her devastated and naked, and **will** eat up her fleshy parts and **will** completely burn her with fire. (**Revelation 17:16**)
- For God put it into their hearts to carry out his thought, **even** to carry out their one thought by giving their kingdom to the wild beast, until the words of God **will** have been accomplished. (**Revelation 17:17**)
- And the woman whom you saw means the great city that has a kingdom over the kings of the earth. (**Revelation 17:18**)
- And they proceeded to come and lay **siege against** him in Abel of Beth-maacah and cast up a **siege rampart against** the city, as it was standing within a **rampart**. And all the people that were with Joab were undermining the **wall**, to **throw** it down. (**2 Samuel 20:15**)
- In his right hand the divination proved to be for Jerusalem, to set battering rams, to open one's mouth for a slaying, to **raise** the

- sound in an alarm signal, to set battering rams **against** gates, to **throw** up a **siege rampart**, to build a **siege wall**. (**Ezekiel 21:22**)
- And it **must** occur that the nation and the kingdom that **will** not serve him, **even** Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon, and the one that **will** not put its neck under the yoke of the king of Babylon, with the **sword** and with the famine and with the pestilence I shall turn my attention upon that nation, is the utterance of Yehowah, until I shall have finished them off by his hand. (**Jeremiah 27:8**)
