Ezekiel 27:12... Tarshish was your merchant because of the abundance of all sorts of valuable things. For its silver, iron, tin and lead, your stores were given.¹

- I have made you a metal tester among my people, one making a thorough search, and you will take note and you must examine their way. (Jeremiah 6:27)
- All of them are the most stubborn men, walking about as slanderers, copper and iron. They are all of them ruinous. (Jeremiah 6:28)
- The bellows have been scorched. Out from their fire there is lead. One has kept refining intensely simply for nothing, and those who are bad have not been separated. (Jeremiah 6:29)
- Rejected silver is what people will certainly call them, for Yehowah has rejected them. (Jeremiah 6:30)
- And you must say to Tyre; O you who are dwelling at the entrances of the sea, the tradeswoman of the peoples for many islands, this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; O Tyre, you yourself have said, I am perfect in prettiness. (Ezekiel 27:3)
- And the sons of Javan were Elishah and Tarshish, Kittim and Dodanim. (Genesis 10:4)
- For the king had a fleet of ships of Tarshish on the sea along with Hiram's fleet of ships. Once every three years the fleet of ships of Tarshish would come carrying gold and silver, ivory, and apes and peacocks. (1 Kings 10:22)
- And upon all the ships of Tarshish and upon all desirable boats. (Isaiah 2:16)
- And Jonah proceeded to get up and run away to Tarshish from before Yehowah, and he finally came down to Joppa and found a ship going to Tarshish. So he paid its fare and went down into it, in order to go with them to Tarshish from before Yehowah.

 (Jonah 1:3)

- For ships belonging to the king were going to Tarshish with the servants of Hiram. Once every three years ships of Tarshish would come in, carrying gold and silver, ivory, and apes and peacocks. (2 Chronicles 9:21)
- So he made him a partner with himself in making ships to go to Tarshish and they made ships in Ezion-geber. (2 Chronicles 20:36)
- The kings of Tarshish and of the islands, tribute they will pay. The kings of Sheba and of Seba, a gift they will present. (Psalms 72:10)
- Silver beaten into plates is what is brought in even from Tarshish, and gold from Uphaz, the workmanship of a craftsman and of the hands of a metalworker, their clothing is blue thread and wool dyed reddish purple. They are all the workmanship of skilled people. (Jeremiah 10:9)
- By the abundance of your wisdom, by your sales goods, you have made your wealth abound, and your heart began to be haughty because of your wealth. (Ezekiel 28:5)
- Because of the abundance of your sales goods they filled the midst of you with violence, and you began to sin. And I shall put you as profane out of the mountain of God, and I shall destroy you, O cherub that is covering, from the midst of the fiery stones. (Ezekiel 28:16)
- A full stock of gold and silver and precious stone and pearls and fine linen and purple and silk and scarlet, and everything in scented wood and every sort of ivory object and every sort of object out of most precious wood and of copper and of iron and of marble. (Revelation 18:12)
