- The inhabitants of Sidon and of Arvad themselves became rowers for you. Your skilled ones, O Tyre, happened to be in you, they were your **sailors**. (**Ezekiel 27:8**)
- Even old **men** of Gebal and her skilled ones happened to be in you as **caulkers** for your **seams**. All the ships of the **sea** and their **mariners** themselves proved to be in you, in order to **exchange articles of merchandise**. (**Ezekiel 27:9**)

- This is your lot, your measured portion from me, is the utterance of Yehowah, because you have forgotten me and you keep putting your trust in falsehood. (**Jeremiah 13:25**)
