Ezekiel 27:36. As for merchants among the peoples, they will certainly whistle over you. Sudden terrors are what you must become, and you will be no more to time indefinite.

- Also, the traveling merchants of the earth are weeping and mourning over her, because there is no one to buy their full stock anymore. (Revelation 18:11)
- The traveling merchants of these things, who became rich from her, will stand at a distance because of their fear of her torment and will weep and mourn. (Revelation 18:15)
- And they threw dust upon their heads and cried out, weeping and mourning, and said; Too bad, too bad, the great city, in which all those having boats at sea became rich by reason of her costliness, because in one hour she has been devastated!

  (Revelation 18:19)
- And a strong angel lifted up a stone like a great millstone and hurled it into the sea, saying; Thus with a swift pitch will Babylon the great city be hurled down, and she will never be found again. (Revelation 18:21)
- In order to make their land an object of astonishment, for whistling at to time indefinite. Every last one passing along by it will stare in astonishment and shake his head. (Jeremiah 18:16)
- And I will make this city an object of astonishment and something to be whistled at. Every last one passing along by it will stare in astonishment and whistle over all its plagues. (Jeremiah 19:8)
- And just a little while longer, and the wicked one will be no more, and you will certainly give attention to his place, and he will not be. (Psalms 37:10)
- And I will make you a shining, bare surface of a crag. A drying yard for dragnets is what you will become. Never will you be rebuilt, for I myself, Yehowah, have spoken, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (Ezekiel 26:14)
- I will also bring you down with those going down into the pit to the people of long ago, and I will cause you to dwell in the lowest

- land, like places devastated for a long time, with those going down into the pit, in order that you may not be inhabited, and I will put decoration in the land of those alive. (Ezekiel 26:20)
- And will they not lie down with mighty ones, falling from among the uncircumcised, who have gone down to Sheol with their weapons of war? And they will put their swords under their heads, and their errors will come to be upon their bones, because mighty ones were a terror in the land of those alive. (Ezekiel 32:27)
