- And they threw dust upon their heads and cried out, weeping and mourning, and said; Too bad, too bad, the great city, in which all those having boats at sea became rich by reason of her costliness, because in one hour she has been devastated! (**Revelation 18:19**)
- And a strong angel lifted up a stone like a great millstone and hurled it into the sea, saying; Thus with a swift pitch **will** Babylon the great city be hurled down, and she **will** never be found again. (**Revelation 18:21**)
- In order to make their land an object of astonishment, for whistling at to time **indefinite**. Every last one passing along by it **will** stare in astonishment and shake his head. (**Jeremiah 18:16**)
