Even old men of Gebal and her skilled ones happened to be in you as caulkers for your seams.¹ All the ships of the sea and their mariners themselves proved to be in you, in order to exchange articles of merchandise.

- To the south all the land of the Canaanites, and Mearah, which belongs to the Sidonians, as far as Aphek, as far as the border of the Amorites. (Joshua 13:4)
- Those going down to the sea in the ships, doing business on vast waters. (Psalms 107:23)

And they threw dust upon their heads and cried out, weeping and mourning, and said, Too bad, too bad, the great city, in which all those having boats at sea became rich by reason of her costliness, because in one hour she has been devastated! (Revelation 18:19)
