

Ezekiel 28:17 **Your heart became haughty because of your beauty. You brought your wisdom to ruin on account of your beaming splendor. Onto the earth I will throw you. Before kings I will set you, for them to look upon you.**

[23] - References:

- Then he said to his disciples. It is unavoidable that causes for stumbling should come. Nevertheless, woe to the one through whom they come! (Luke 17:1)
- It would be of more advantage to him if a millstone were suspended from his neck and he were thrown into the sea than for him to stumble one of these little ones. (Luke 17:2)
- Pay attention to yourselves. If your brother commits a sin give him a rebuke, and if he repents forgive him. (Luke 17:3)
- Even if he sins seven times a day against you and he comes back to you seven times, saying; I repent, you must forgive him. (Luke 17:4)
- Now the apostles said to the Lord; Give us more faith. (Luke 17:5)
- Then the Lord said; If **you** had faith the size of a mustard grain, **you** would say to this black mulberry tree; Be uprooted and planted in the sea! And it would obey **you**. (Luke 17:6)
- Who of **you** is there that has a slave plowing or minding the flock who **will** say to him when he gets in from the field, Come here at once and recline at the table? (Luke 17:7)
- Rather, **will** he not say to him; Get something ready for me to have my evening meal, and put on an apron and minister to me until I am through eating and drinking, and afterward you can eat and drink? (Luke 17:8)
- He **will** not feel gratitude to the slave because he did the things assigned, **will** he? (Luke 17:9)
- So **you**, also, when **you** have done all the things assigned to **you**, say; We are good-for-nothing slaves. What we have done is what we ought to have done. (Luke 17:10)

- And I went on to say to them; Throw away, each one of **you**, the disgusting things of his eyes, and with the dungy idols of Egypt do not defile yourselves. I am Yehowah **YOUR** God. (**Ezekiel 20:7**)
- Will you without fail say; I am god, before the one killing you, whereas you are a mere earthling man, and not a god, in the hand of those profaning you? (**Ezekiel 28:9**)
- Yehowah of armies himself has given this counsel, to profane the pride of all **beauty**, to treat with contempt all the honorable ones of the **earth**. (**Isaiah 23:9**)
- And I proceeded to take the cup out of the hand of Yehowah and to make all the nations drink to whom Yehowah had sent me. (**Jeremiah 25:17**)
- And all the **kings** of Tyre and all the **kings** of Sidon and the **kings** of the island that is in the region of the sea. (**Jeremiah 25:22**)
- On **account** of the day that is coming to despoil all the Philistines, to cut off from Tyre and from Sidon every survivor that was helping. For Yehowah is despoiling the Philistines, who are the remaining ones from the island of Caphtor. (**Jeremiah 47:4**)
- And I **will** sell **YOUR** sons and **YOUR** daughters into the hand of the sons of Judah, and they must sell them to the men of Sheba, to a nation far away, for Yehowah himself has spoken it. (**Joel 3:8**)
- Has presumptuousness come? Then dishonor **will** come, but **wisdom** is with the modest ones. (**Proverbs 11:2**)
- Pride is before a crash, and a **haughty** spirit before stumbling. (**Proverbs 16:18**)
- And you must say to Tyre; O you who are dwelling at the entrances of the sea, the tradeswoman of the peoples for many islands, this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; O Tyre, you yourself have said, I am perfect in prettiness. (**Ezekiel 27:3**)
- I shall go up above the high places of the clouds; I shall make myself resemble the Most High. (**Isaiah 14:14**)
- The wise ones have become ashamed. They have become terrified and **will** be caught. Look! They have rejected the very

- word of Yehowah, and what **wisdom** do they have? (**Jeremiah 8:9**)
- Let flow the furious outbursts of your anger, and see every one **haughty** and bring him low. (**Job 40:11**)
 - Surely on slippery ground is where you place them. You have made them fall to **ruins**. (**Psalms 73:18**)
 - Yehowah is relieving the meek ones, he is abasing the wicked ones to the **earth**. (**Psalms 147:6**)
 - However, down to Sheol you **will** be **brought**, to the remotest parts of the pit. (**Isaiah 14:15**)
 - Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Here I am against you, O Tyre, and I **will** bring up against you many nations, just as the sea brings up its waves. (**Ezekiel 26:3**)
 - Even Sheol underneath has become agitated at you in order to meet you on coming in. At you it has awakened those impotent in death, all the goatlike leaders of the **earth**. It has made all the **kings** of the nations get up from their thrones. (**Isaiah 14:9**)
 - O how you have fallen from heaven, you shining one, son of the dawn! How you have been cut down to the **earth**, you who were disabling the nations! (**Isaiah 14:12**)
 - All the inhabitants of the islands, in amazement they **will** certainly stare at you, and their **kings** themselves **will** have to shudder in horror. Faces must become perturbed. (**Ezekiel 27:35**)
 - Son of man, lift up a dirge concerning the king of Tyre, and you must say to him; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; You are sealing up a pattern, full of **wisdom** and perfect in **beauty**. (**Ezekiel 28:12**)
 - Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; For the reason that you **became** high in stature, so that it put its treetop even among the clouds and its heart **became** exalted because of its height. (**Ezekiel 31:10**)
 - Not a newly converted man, for fear that he might get puffed up with pride and fall into the judgment passed upon the Devil. (**1 Timothy 3:6**)
