Son of Man, say to the leader of Tyre, This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; For the reason that your heart has become haughty, and you keep saying, I am a god. In the seat of god I have seated myself, in the heart of the open sea, whereas an earthling man is what you are, and not a god, and you keep making your heart like the heart of god.

- In a flaming fire, as he brings vengeance upon those who do not know God and those who do not obey the Good News about our Lord Jesus. (2 Thessalonians 1:8)
- These very ones will undergo the judicial punishment of everlasting destruction from before the Lord and from the glory of his strength. (2 Thessalonians 1:9)
- At the time he comes to be glorified in connection with his holy ones and to be regarded in that day with wonder in connection with all those who exercised faith, because the witness we gave met with faith among You. (2 Thessalonians 1:10)
- Pride is before a crash, and a haughty spirit before stumbling. (Proverbs 16:18)
- For it is the day belonging to Yehowah of armies. It is upon everyone self-exalted and lofty and upon everyone lifted up or low. (Isaiah 2:12)
- By the abundance of your wisdom, by your sales goods, you have made your wealth abound, and your heart began to be haughty because of your wealth. (Ezekiel 28:5)
- And the king will actually do according to his own will, and he will exalt himself and magnify himself above every god, and against the God of gods he will speak marvelous things. And he will certainly prove successful until the denunciation will have come to a finish, because the thing decided upon must be done. (Daniel 11:36)
