

Ezekiel 28:22

And you must say, This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Here I am against you, O Sidon, and I shall certainly be glorified in the midst of you, and people will have to know that I am Yehowah when I execute acts of judgment in her and I am actually sanctified in her.

- **And I heard another voice out of heaven say; Get out of her, my people, if you do not want to share with her in her sins, and if you do not want to receive part of her plagues. (Revelation 18:4)**
- **For her sins have massed together clear up to heaven, and God has called her acts of injustice to mind. (Revelation 18:5)**
- **Render to her even as she herself rendered, and do to her twice as much, yes, twice the number of the things she did, in the cup in which she put a mixture put twice as much of the mixture for her. (Revelation 18:6)**
- **To the extent that she glorified herself and lived in shameless luxury, to that extent give her torment and mourning. For in her heart she keeps saying, I sit a queen, and I am no widow, and I shall never see mourning. (Revelation 18:7)**
- **That is why in one day her plagues will come, death and mourning and famine, and she will be completely burned with fire, because Yehowah God, who judged her, is strong. (Revelation 18:8)**
- **And I saw that the woman was drunk with the blood of the holy ones and with the blood of the witnesses of Jesus. Well, on catching sight of her I wondered with great wonderment. (Revelation 17:6)**
- **With that he spoke an illustration to them, saying; The land of a certain rich man produced well. (Luke 12:16)**
- **Consequently he began reasoning within himself, saying, What shall I do, now that I have nowhere to gather my crops? (Luke 12:17)**
- **So he said, I will do this; I will tear down my storehouses and build bigger ones, and there I will gather all my grain and all my good things. (Luke 12:18)**

- And I **will say** to my soul; Soul, you **have** many good things laid up for many years, take your ease, eat, drink, enjoy yourself. (**Luke 12:19**)
- But God **said** to him; Unreasonable one, this night they are demanding your soul from you. Who, then, is to **have** the things you stored up? (**Luke 12:20**)
- So it goes with the man that lays up treasure for himself but is not rich toward God. (**Luke 12:21**)
- Do **you** imagine I came to give peace on the earth? No, indeed, I tell **you**, but rather division. (**Luke 12:51**)
- For from now on there **will** be five in one house divided, three **against** two and two **against** three. (**Luke 12:52**)
- They **will** be divided, father **against** son and son **against** father, mother **against** daughter and daughter **against** her mother, mother-in-law **against** her daughter-in-law and daughter-in-law **against** her mother-in-law. (**Luke 12:53**)
- Therefore this is **what** the **Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said**; Here I **am against** you, O Tyre, and I **will** bring up **against** you many nations, just as the sea brings up its waves. (**Ezekiel 26:3**)
- But, in fact, for this cause I **have** kept you in existence, for the sake of showing you my power and in order to **have** my name declared in all the earth. (**Exodus 9:16**)
- And all the **people** of the land **will have** to do the burying, and it **will certainly** become for them a matter of fame in the day that I glorify myself, is the utterance of the **Sovereign Lord Yehowah**. (**Ezekiel 39:13**)
- Yehowah is known by the **judgment** that he **has** executed. By the activity of his own hands the wicked one **has** been ensnared. (**Psalms 9:16**)
- Because of the restful odor I shall take pleasure in **you**, when I bring **you** forth from the **peoples** and I **actually** collect **you** together from the lands to which **you have** been scattered, and I **will** be **sanctified** in **you** before the eyes of the nations. (**Ezekiel 20:41**)

- And I shall **certainly** sanctify my great name, which was being profaned among the nations, which **you** profaned in the **midst** of them, and the nations **will have to know** that I **am** Yehowah, is the utterance of the **Sovereign Lord** Yehowah, when I **am sanctified** among **you** before their eyes. (**Ezekiel 36:23**)
- And I shall **certainly** magnify myself and sanctify myself and make myself known before the eyes of many nations, and they **will have to know** that I **am** Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 38:23**)
