

**Ezekiel 28:24** And no more will there prove to be to the house of Israel a malignant prickle or a painful thorn out of all those round about them, those who are treating them with scorn, and people will have to know that I am the Sovereign Lord Yehowah.

[5] - References:

- Before your own badness got to be exposed, just as at the time of the reproach of the daughters of Syria and of all round about her, the daughters of the Philistines, those treating you with scorn on all sides. (**Ezekiel 16:57**)
- This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; In the day of my cleansing YOU from all YOUR errors I will also cause the cities to be inhabited, and the devastated places must be rebuilt. (**Ezekiel 36:33**)
- And the desolated land itself will be cultivated, whereas it had become a desolate waste before the eyes of every passerby. (**Ezekiel 36:34**)
- And people will certainly say; That land yonder which was laid desolate has become like the garden of Eden, and the cities that were a waste and that were laid desolate and that were torn down are fortified, they have become inhabited. (**Ezekiel 36:35**)
- And the nations that will be left remaining round about you will have to know that I myself, Yehowah, have built the things torn down, I have planted what has been laid desolate. I myself, Yehowah, have spoken and I have done it. (**Ezekiel 36:36**)
- If, though, you will not drive the inhabitants of the land away from before you, then those whom you leave of them will certainly become as pricks in YOUR eyes and as thorns in YOUR sides, and they will indeed harass you on the land in which you will be dwelling. (**Numbers 33:55**)
- You should positively know that Yehowah YOUR God will not continue to dispossess these nations on YOUR account, and they must become to you as a trap and as a snare and as a scourge on YOUR flanks and as thorns in YOUR eyes until you have perished off this good ground that Yehowah YOUR God has given you. (**Joshua 23:13**)

- **And it must occur in the day when Yehowah gives you rest from your pain and from your agitation and from the hard slavery in which you were made a slave. (Isaiah 14:3)**
