have made your wealth abound, and your heart began to be haughty because of your wealth.

- And upon all the ships of Tarshish and upon all desirable boats.

- And the haughtiness of the earthling man must bow down, and the loftiness of men must become low, and Yehowah alone must be put on high in that day. (Isaiah 2:17)
- But Jesus, calling them to him, said; You know that the rulers of the nations lord it over them and the great men wield authority over them. (Matthew 20:25)
- This is not the way among You, but whoever wants to become great among You must be Your minister. (Matthew 20:26)
- And whoever wants to be first among you must be your slave. (Matthew 20:27)
