- Yehowah of armies himself has given this counsel, to **profane** the pride of all **beauty**, to treat with contempt all the honorable ones of the earth. (**Isaiah 23:9**)
- He and his people with him, the **tyrants** of the **nations**, are being brought in to reduce the land to ruin. And they must **draw** their **swords against** Egypt and fill the land with the slain. (**Ezekiel 30:11**)
- A nation fierce in countenance, who **will** not be partial to an old man or show favor to a young man. (**Deuteronomy 28:50**)
- Yehowah of armies himself has given this counsel, to **profane** the pride of all **beauty**, to treat with contempt all the honorable ones of the earth. (**Isaiah 23:9**)
- For an extermination has been made, and what of it if it is rejecting also the scepter? This **will** not continue existing, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 21:13**)
- This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; I **will** also cause the crowd of Egypt to cease by the hand of Nebuchadrezzar the king of Babylon. (**Ezekiel 30:10**)
- For this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; The very sword of the king of Babylon **will** come upon you. (**Ezekiel 32:11**)
- And I proceeded to scatter them among the **nations**, so that they were dispersed among the lands. According to their way and according to their dealings I judged them. (**Ezekiel 36:19**)
