Ezekiel 29:11... There will not pass through it the foot of earthling man, nor will the foot of domestic animal pass through it, and for forty years it will not be inhabited.

- And you must remember all the way that Yehowah your God made you walk these forty years in the wilderness, in order to humble you, to put you to the test so as to know what was in your heart, as to whether you would keep his commandments or not. (Deuteronomy 8:2)
- And strangers, the tyrants of the nations, will cut it down, and people will abandon it upon the mountains, and in all the valleys its foliage will certainly fall, and its branches will be broken among all the streambeds of the earth. And out from its shade all the peoples of the earth will come down and abandon it. (Ezekiel 31:12)
- And I will destroy all her domestic animals from beside many waters, and the foot of earthling man will no more muddy them, nor will even the hoofs of a domestic animal muddy them. (Ezekiel 32:13)
- To fulfill Yehowah's word by the mouth of Jeremiah, until the land had paid off its Sabbaths. All the days of lying desolated it kept Sabbath, to fulfill seventy years. (2 Chronicles 36:21)
- By night or by day it will not be extinguished, to time indefinite its smoke will keep ascending. From generation to generation she will be parched, forever and ever no one will be passing across her. (Isaiah 34:10)
- For this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; At the end of forty years I shall collect the Egyptians together out of the peoples among whom they will have been scattered. (Ezekiel 29:13)
- And I shall certainly make the mountainous region of Seir a desolate waste, even a desolation, and I will cut off from it the one passing through and the one returning. (Ezekiel 35:7)
