

Ezekiel 29:21 **“ In that day I shall cause a horn to sprout for the house of Israel, and to you I shall give occasion to open the mouth in the midst of them, and they will have to know that I am Yehowah.**

[9] - References:

- And I **will** raise up over them one shepherd, and he must feed them, even my servant David. He himself **will** feed them, and he himself **will** become their shepherd. (**Ezekiel 34:23**)
- And I myself, Yehowah, **will** become their God, and my servant David a chieftain in the **midst** of them. I myself, Yehowah, **have** spoken. (**Ezekiel 34:24**)
- As for Yehowah, those contending against him **will** be terrified, Against them he **will** thunder in the heavens. Yehowah himself **will** judge the ends of the earth, that he may **give** strength to his king, that he may exalt the **horn** of his anointed one. (**1 Samuel 2:10**)
- There I shall cause the **horn** of David to grow. I **have** set in order a lamp for my anointed one. (**Psalms 132:17**)
- Look! There are **days** coming, is the utterance of Yehowah, and I **will** raise up to David a righteous **sprout**. And a king **will** certainly reign and act with discretion and execute justice and righteousness in the land. (**Jeremiah 23:5**)
- And he has raised up a **horn** of salvation for us in the **house** of David his servant. (**Luke 1:69**)
- O Yehowah, may you **open** these lips of mine, that my own **mouth** may tell forth your praise. (**Psalms 51:15**)
- And when I speak with you I shall **open** your **mouth**, and you must say to them; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said. Let the one hearing hear, and let the one refraining refrain, because they are a rebellious **house**. (**Ezekiel 3:27**)
- In that day your **mouth will** be opened to the escaped one, and you **will** speak and be mute no longer, and you **will** certainly become to them a portent, and they **will have** to **know** that I **am** Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 24:27**)

- **For I will give you a mouth and wisdom, which all your opposers together will not be able to resist or dispute. (Luke 21:15)**
