

Ezekiel 2:3 And he went on to say to me; **Son of Man, I am sending you to the sons of Israel, to rebellious nations that have rebelled against me. They themselves and their forefathers have transgressed against me down to this selfsame day.**

[19] - References:

- And Yehowah the God of their **forefathers** kept **sending against** them by means of his messengers, **sending** again and again, because he felt compassion for his people and for his dwelling. (**2 Chronicles 36:15**)
- Now as regards you, O son of man, a watchman is what I **have** made you to the house of **Israel**, and at my mouth you must hear the word and give them warning from me. (**Ezekiel 33:7**)
- Look! I **am sending you** forth as sheep amidst wolves, therefore prove yourselves cautious as serpents and yet innocent as doves. (**Matthew 10:16**)
- For they had behaved rebelliously **against** the sayings of God, and the counsel of the Most High they had disrespected. (**Psalms 107:11**)
- Woe to the sinful nation, the people heavy with error, an evildoing seed, ruinous **sons**! They **have** left Yehowah, they **have** treated the Holy One of **Israel** with disrespect, they **have** turned backwards. (**Isaiah 1:4**)
- For it is a **rebellious** people, untruthful **sons**, **sons** who **have** been unwilling to hear the Law of Yehowah. (**Isaiah 30:9**)
- And **you** yourselves **have** acted worse in **your** doing than **your** fathers, and here **you** are walking each one after the stubbornness of his bad heart in not obeying me. (**Jeremiah 16:12**)
- See, O Yehowah, for I **am** in sore straits. My very intestines are in a ferment. My heart has been overturned in the midst of me, for I **have** been absolutely **rebellious**. Outside the sword caused bereavement of children. Within the house it is the same as death. (**Lamentations 1:20**)
- To Yehowah our God belong the mercies and the acts of forgiveness, for we **have rebelled against** him. (**Daniel 9:9**)

- **You have** proved yourselves **rebellious** in behavior with Yehowah from the **day** of my knowing **you**. (**Deuteronomy 9:24**)
- However, they became disobedient and **rebelled against** you and kept casting your Law behind their back, and your own prophets they killed, who bore witness **against** them to bring them back to you, and they went on committing acts of great disrespect. (**Nehemiah 9:26**)
- And they should not become like their **forefathers**, a generation stubborn and **rebellious**, a generation who had not prepared their heart and whose spirit was not trustworthy with God. (**Psalms 78:8**)
- We lie **down** in our shame, and our humiliation keeps covering us, for it is toward Yehowah our God that we **have** sinned, we and our fathers from our youth on and **down** to this **day**, and we **have** not obeyed the voice of Yehowah our God. (**Jeremiah 3:25**)
- And I proceeded to **say** to their **sons** in the wilderness, In the regulations of your **forefathers** do not **you** walk, and their judgments do not **you** keep, and with their dungy idols do not **you** defile yourselves. (**Ezekiel 20:18**)
- Obstinate men and uncircumcised in hearts and ears, **you** are always resisting the Holy Spirit, as **your forefathers** did, so **you** do. (**Acts of Apostles 7:51**)
- Many times he would deliver them, but they themselves would behave rebelliously in their disobedient course, and they would be brought low for their error. (**Psalms 106:43**)
- Like guards of the open field they **have** become **against** her on all sides, because she has **rebelled** even **against** me, is the utterance of Yehowah. (**Jeremiah 4:17**)
- Son of man, in the midst of a **rebellious** house is where you are dwelling, that **have** eyes to see but they actually do not see, that **have** ears to hear but they actually do not hear, for they are a **rebellious** house. (**Ezekiel 12:2**)
- And Yehowah proceeded to take me from following the flock, and Yehowah went on to **say** to me; Go, prophesy to my people Israel. (**Amos 7:15**)
