Ezekiel 2:5... And as for them, whether they will hear or will refrain, for they are a rebellious house, they will certainly know also that a prophet himself happened to be in the midst of them.

- And the wicked one returns the very thing pledged, pays back the very things taken by robbery, and actually walks in the very statutes of life by not doing injustice, he will positively keep living. He will not die. (Ezekiel 33:15)
- And go, enter in among the exiled people, among the sons of your people, and you must speak to them and say to them, This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said, regardless of whether they hear or they refrain. (Ezekiel 3:11)
- And the hearer actually hears the sound of the horn but he takes no warning at all, and a sword comes and takes him away, his own blood will come to be upon his own head. (Ezekiel 33:4)
- Son of man, in the midst of a rebellious house is where you are dwelling, that have eyes to see but they actually do not see, that have ears to hear but they actually do not hear, for they are a rebellious house. (Ezekiel 12:2)
- And when it comes true, look! It must come true, they will also have to know that a prophet himself had proved to be in the midst of them. (Ezekiel 33:33)
- If I had not come and spoken to them, they would have no sin, but now they have no excuse for their sin. (John 15:22)
- And the word of Yehowah continued to occur to me, saying; (Ezekiel 17:11)
- And you must say to Rebelliousness, to the house of Israel; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; That is enough of you because of all your detestable things, O house of Israel. (Ezekiel 44:6)
