- And the wicked one returns the very thing pledged, pays back the very things taken by robbery, and actually walks in the very statutes of life by not doing injustice, he **will** positively keep living. He **will** not die. (**Ezekiel 33:15**)
- And go, enter in among the exiled people, among the sons of your people, and you must speak to them and say to them, This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said, regardless of whether they **hear** or they refrain. (**Ezekiel 3:11**)
- And the hearer actually **hears** the sound of the horn but he takes no warning at all, and a sword comes and takes him away, his own blood **will** come to be upon his own head. (**Ezekiel 33:4**)
- Son of man, in the **midst** of a **rebellious house** is where you are dwelling, that have eyes to see but they actually do not see, that have ears to **hear** but they actually do not **hear**, for they are a **rebellious house**. (**Ezekiel 12:2**)
- And when it comes true, look! It must come true, they **will** also have to **know** that a **prophet** himself had proved to be in the **midst** of them. (**Ezekiel 33:33**)
- If I had not come and spoken to them, they would have no sin, but now they have no excuse for their sin. (**John 15:22**)

- And you must say to Rebelliousness, to the **house** of Israel; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; That is enough of **YOU** because of all **YOUR** detestable things, O **house** of Israel. (**Ezekiel 44:6**)
