

Ezekiel 2:6

And you, O Son of Man, do not be afraid of them, and of their words do not be afraid, because there are obstinate ones and things pricking you and it is among scorpions that you are dwelling. Of their words do not you be afraid, and at their faces do not you be struck with terror, for they are a rebellious house.

[16] - References:

- At that the angel of Yehowah spoke to Elijah; Go down with him. Do not be **afraid** because of him. So he rose and went down with him to the king. (**2 Kings 1:15**)
- Trembling at men is what lays a snare, but he that is trusting in Yehowah will be protected. (**Proverbs 29:25**)
- And as for you, you should gird up your hips, and you must rise up and speak to them everything that I myself command you. Do not be **struck** with any **terror** because of them, in order that I may not strike you with **terror** before them. (**Jeremiah 1:17**)
- Moreover, I say to **you**, my friends; Do not fear those who kill the body and after this are not able to do anything more. (**Luke 12:4**)
- And Sihon the king of Heshbon did not let us pass through him, because Yehowah your God had let his spirit become **obstinate** and his heart become hard, in order to give him into your hand just as at this day. (**Deuteronomy 2:30**)
- Obstinate men and uncircumcised in hearts and ears, **you** are always resisting the Holy Spirit, as **your** forefathers did, so **you** do. (**Acts of Apostles 7:51**)
- For wickedness has become aflame just like a fire, thornbushes and weeds it will eat up. And it will catch fire in the thickets of the forest, and they will be borne aloft as the billowing of smoke. (**Isaiah 9:18**)
- Their best one is like a brier, their most upright one is worse than a thorn hedge. The day of your watchmen, of your being given attention, must come. Now will occur the confounding of them. (**Micah 7:4**)
- Look! I have given **you** the authority to trample underfoot serpents and **scorpions**, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing will by any means do **you** hurt. (**Luke 10:19**)

- Like a diamond, harder than flint, I have made your forehead. You must not be **afraid** of them, and you must not be **struck** with **terror** at their **faces**, for they are a **rebellious** house. (**Ezekiel 3:9**)
- Do not be **afraid** because of their **faces**, for, I am with you to deliver you, is the utterance of Yehowah. (**Jeremiah 1:8**)
- Listen to me, **you** the **ones** knowing righteousness, the people in whose heart is my Law. Do not be **afraid** of the reproach of mortal men, and do not be **struck** with **terror** just because of their abusive **words**. (**Isaiah 51:7**)
- Then Yehowah said to Moses; Pass in front of the people and take with you some of the older men of Israel and your rod with which you **struck** the Nile River. Take it in your hand and you must walk on. (**Exodus 17:5**)
- For this reason he had been hired in order that I might be **afraid** and do that way, and I should certainly sin and it should certainly become in their possession a bad reputation, in order that they might reproach me. (**Nehemiah 6:13**)
- For too long a time my soul has tabernacled with the haters of peace. (**Psalms 120:6**)
- And your very tongue I will make stick to the roof of your mouth, and you will certainly become mute, and you will not become to them a man administering reproof, because they are a **rebellious house**. (**Ezekiel 3:26**)
