[5] - References:

- And as for you, you should gird up your hips, and you must rise up and **speak** to them everything that I myself command you. Do not be struck with any terror because of them, in order that I may not strike you with terror before them. (**Jeremiah 1:17**)
- And when I **speak** with you I shall open your mouth, and you must say to them, This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said. Let the one hearing **hear**, and let the one refraining **refrain**, because they are a rebellious house. (**Ezekiel 3:27**)
- And you must **speak** to them all these **words**, but they will not listen to you, and you must call to them, but they will not answer you. (**Jeremiah 7:27**)
- And I began to **speak** to the exiled people all the things of Yehowah that he had caused me to see. (**Ezekiel 11:25**)
- Therefore **speak** to the house of Israel, O son of man, and you must say to them; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Yet in this respect, **YOUR** forefathers spoke abusively of me, in their acting against me with unfaithfulness. (**Ezekiel 20:27**)
