

**Ezekiel 30:18** And in Tehaphnehes the day will actually grow dark, when I break there the yoke bars of Egypt. And in her the pride of her strength will actually be made to cease. As for her, clouds themselves will cover her, and into captivity her own dependent towns<sup>1</sup> will go.

[14] - References:

- Let their way become darkness and slippery places, and let Yehowah's angel be pursuing them. (**Psalms 35:6**)
- It is a **day** of darkness and gloominess, a **day** of **clouds** and thick gloom, like light of dawn spread out upon the mountains. There is a people numerous and mighty, one like it has not been **made** to exist from the indefinite past, and after it there **will** be none again to the years of generation after generation. (**Joel 2:2**)
- I saw also an angel standing in the sun, and he cried out with a loud voice and said to all the birds that fly in midheaven; Come here, be gathered together to the great evening meal of God. (**Revelation 19:17**)
- That **you** may eat the fleshy parts of kings and the fleshy parts of military commanders and the fleshy parts of strong men and the fleshy parts of horses and of those seated upon them, and the fleshy parts of all, of freemen as well as of slaves and of small ones and great. (**Revelation 19:18**)
- And I saw the wild beast and the kings of the earth and their armies gathered together to wage the war with the one seated on the horse and with his army. (**Revelation 19:19**)
- And the wild beast was caught, and along with it the false prophet that performed in front of it the signs with which he misled those who received the mark of the wild beast and those who render worship to its image. While still alive, they both were hurled into the fiery lake that burns with sulphur. (**Revelation 19:20**)
- But the rest were killed off with the long sword of the one seated on the horse, which sword proceeded out of his mouth. And all the birds were filled from the fleshy parts of them. (**Revelation 19:21**)

- Even the sons of Noph and Tahpanes themselves kept feeding on you at the crown of the head. (**Jeremiah 2:16**)
- And they **will** have to know that I am Yehowah when I set a fire in **Egypt** and all its helpers are **actually** broken. (**Ezekiel 30:8**)
- Make for yourself mere baggage for exile, O inhabitress, the daughter of **Egypt**. For Noph itself **will** become a mere object of astonishment and **will actually** be set afire, so as to be without an inhabitant. (**Jeremiah 46:19**)
- **Egypt** is as a very pretty heifer. From the north a mosquito itself **will** certainly come against her. (**Jeremiah 46:20**)
- Whom have you come to resemble thus in glory and greatness among the trees of Eden? But you **will** certainly be brought down with the trees of Eden to the land down below. In the midst of the uncircumcised ones you **will** lie down with those slain by the sword. This is Pharaoh and all his crowd, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 31:18**)
- The pronouncement against **Egypt**! Look! Yehowah is riding on a swift cloud and coming into **Egypt**. And the valueless gods of **Egypt will** certainly quiver because of him, and the very heart of **Egypt will** melt in the midst of it. (**Isaiah 19:1**)
- And they finally came into the land of **Egypt**, for they did not obey the voice of Yehowah, and they came gradually as far as Tahpanhes. (**Jeremiah 43:7**)
- And he must come in and strike the land of **Egypt**. Whoever is due for deadly plague **will** be for deadly plague, and whoever is due for **captivity will** be for **captivity**, and whoever is due for the sword **will** be for the sword. (**Jeremiah 43:11**)
- The word that occurred to Jeremiah for all the Jews that were dwelling in the land of **Egypt**, the ones dwelling in Migdol and in Tahpanhes and in Noph and in the land of Pathros, saying; (**Jeremiah 44:1**)
- Tell it in **Egypt**, O men, and publish it in Migdol, and publish it in Noph and in Tahpanhes. Say; Station yourself, making preparation also for yourself, for a sword **will** certainly devour all around you. (**Jeremiah 46:14**)

- This is what Yehowah has said; The supporters of **Egypt** must also fall, and the **pride** of its **strength** must come down. From Migdol to Syene they **will** fall in it even by the sword, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 30:6**)
- And the tree of the field must give its fruitage, and the land itself **will** give its yield, and they **will actually** prove to be on their soil in security. And they **will** have to know that I am Yehowah when I **break** the **bars** of their **yoke** and I have delivered them out of the hand of those who had been using them as slaves. (**Ezekiel 34:27**)
