Son of Man, prophesy, and you must say, This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Howl, you people, Alas for the day!

- Alas for the day, because the day of Yehowah is near, and like a despoiling from the Almighty One it will come! (Joel 1:15)
- Has not food itself been cut off before our very eyes, from the house of our God, rejoicing and joyfulness? (Joel 1:16)
- Blow a horn in Zion, O men, and shout a war cry in my holy mountain. Let all the inhabitants of the land get agitated, for the day of Yehowah is coming, for it is near! (Joel 2:1)
- It is a day of darkness and gloominess, a day of clouds and thick gloom, like light of dawn spread out upon the mountains. There is a people numerous and mighty, one like it has not been made to exist from the indefinite past, and after it there will be none again to the years of generation after generation. (Joel 2:2)
- Ahead of it a fire has devoured, and behind it a flame consumes. Like the garden of Eden the land is ahead of it, but behind it is a desolate wilderness, and there has also proved to be nothing thereof escaping. (Joel 2:3)
- Its appearance is like the appearance of horses, and like steeds is the way they keep running. (Joel 2:4)
- As with the sound of chariots on the tops of the mountains they keep skipping about, as with the sound of a flaming fire that is devouring stubble. It is like a mighty people, drawn up in battle order. (Joel 2:5)
- Because of it, peoples will be in severe pains. As for all faces, they will certainly collect a glow of excitement. (Joel 2:6)
- Woe to those who are craving the day of Yehowah! What, then, will the day of Yehowah mean to you people? It will be darkness, and no light. (Amos 5:18)
- Just as when a man flees because of the lion, and the bear actually meets him, and as when he went into the house and

- supported his hand against the wall, and the serpent bit him. (Amos 5:19)
- Will not the day of Yehowah be darkness, and not light, and will it not have gloom, and not brightness? (Amos 5:20)
- Yehowah is near, for Yehowah has prepared a sacrifice, he has sanctified his invited ones. (Zephaniah 1:7)
- And it must occur on the day of Yehowah's sacrifice that I will give attention to the princes, and to the sons of the king, and to all those wearing foreign attire. (Zephaniah 1:8)
- And I will give attention to everyone that is climbing upon the plaform in that day, those who are filling the house of their masters with violence and deception. (Zephaniah 1:9)
- The great day of Yehowah is near. It is near, and there is a hurrying of it very much. The sound of the day of Yehowah is bitter. There a mighty man is letting out a cry. (Zephaniah 1:14)
- That day is a day of fury, a day of distress and of anguish, a day of storm and of desolation, a day of darkness and of gloominess, a day of clouds and of thick gloom. (Zephaniah 1:15)
- A day of horn and of alarm signal, against the fortified cities and against the high corner towers. (Zephaniah 1:16)
- And I will cause distress to mankind, and they will certainly walk like blind men, because it is against Yehowah that they have sinned. And their blood will actually be poured out like dust, and their bowels like the dung. (Zephaniah 1:17)
- Neither their silver nor their gold will be able to deliver them in the day of Yehowah's fury, but by the fire of his zeal the whole earth will be devoured, because he will make an extermination, indeed a terrible one, of all the inhabitants of the earth. (Zephaniah 1:18)
- For, look! The day is coming that is burning like the furnace, and all the presumptuous ones and all those doing wickedness must become as stubble. And the day that is coming will certainly devour them, Yehowah of armies has said, so that it will not leave to them either root or bough. (Malachi 4:1)

- Look! I am sending to You people Elijah the prophet before the coming of the great and fear-inspiring day of Yehowah. (Malachi 4:5)
- And he must turn the heart of fathers back toward sons, and the heart of sons back toward fathers, in order that I may not come and actually strike the earth with a devoting of it to destruction. (Malachi 4:6)
- I saw all the works that were done under the sun, and, look! Everything was vanity and a striving after wind. (Ecclesiastes 1:14)
- Who through him are believers in God, the one who raised him up from the dead and gave him glory, so that YOUR faith and hope might be in God. (1 Peter 1:21)
