Ezekiel 30:22... Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said, Here I am against Pharaoh the king of Egypt, and I will break his arms, the strong one and the broken one, and I will cause the sword to fall out of his hand.

- We know we originate with God, but the whole world is lying in the power of the wicked one. (1 John 5:19)
- This is what Yehowah has said to his anointed one, to Cyrus, whose right hand I have taken hold of, to subdue before him nations, so that I may ungird even the hips of kings, to open before him the two-leaved doors, so that even the gates will not be shut; (Isaiah 45:1)
- Yehowah of armies, the God of Israel, has said; Here I am turning my attention upon Amon from No and upon Pharaoh and upon Egypt and upon her gods and upon her kings, even upon Pharaoh and upon all those trusting in him. (Jeremiah 46:25)
- Speak, and you must say; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Here I am against you, O Pharaoh, king of Egypt, the great sea monster lying stretched out in the midst of his Nile canals, that has said, My Nile River belongs to me, and I, I have made it for myself. (Ezekiel 29:3)
- For the very arms of the wicked ones will be broken, but Yehowah will be supporting the righteous ones. (Psalms 37:17)
- And never again did the king of Egypt come out from his land, for the king of Babylon had taken all that happened to belong to the king of Egypt from the torrent valley of Egypt up to the river Euphrates. (2 Kings 24:7)
- For Egypt, concerning the military force of Pharaoh Necho the king of Egypt, who happened to be by the river Euphrates at Carchemish, whom Nebuchadrezzar the king of Babylon defeated in the fourth year of Jehoiakim the son of Josiah, the king of Judah. (Jeremiah 46:2)
- Furthermore, her hired soldiers in the midst of her are like fattened calves. But they themselves also have given way, they have fled together. They have not made a stand. For the very

- day of their disaster has come in upon them, the time of their being given attention. (Jeremiah 46:21)
- And from the wicked ones their light is held back, and the high arm itself gets broken. (Job 38:15)
- Woe to my valueless shepherd, who is leaving the flock! A sword will be upon his arm and upon his right eye. His own arm will without fail dry up, and his own right eye will without fail grow dim. (Zechariah 11:17)
