the very arms of Pharaoh will fall, and they will have to know that I am Yehowah when I give my sword into the hand of the king of Babylon and he actually extends it out against the land of Egypt.

- And the Egyptians will certainly know that I am Yehowah when I stretch out my hand against Egypt, and I shall indeed bring the sons of Israel out from their midst. (Exodus 7:5)
- Yehowah is known by the judgment that he has executed. By the activity of his own hands the wicked one has been ensnared. (Psalms 9:16)
- And I will make the land of Egypt a desolate waste in the midst of desolated lands, and its own cities will become a desolate waste in the very midst of devastated cities for forty years, and I will scatter the Egyptians among the nations and disperse them among the lands. (Ezekiel 29:12)
- Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said;
  Here I am giving to Nebuchadrezzar the king of Babylon the land
  of Egypt, and he must carry off its wealth and make a big spoil of
  it and do a great deal of plundering of it, and it must become
  wages for his military force. (Ezekiel 29:19)
- As his compensation for service that he did against her I have given him the land of Egypt, because they acted for me, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (Ezekiel 29:20)
