Ezekiel 30:4... And a sword will certainly come into Egypt, and severe pains must occur in Ethiopia¹ when one falls slain in Egypt and they actually take its wealth and its foundations are actually torn down.

- And the haughtiness of the earthling man must bow down, and the loftiness of men must become low, and Yehowah alone must be put on high in that day. (Isaiah 2:17)
- Look! The nations are as a drop from a bucket, and as the film of dust on the scales they have been accounted. Look! He lifts the islands themselves as mere fine dust. (Isaiah 40:15)
- Even Lebanon is not sufficient for keeping a fire burning, and its wild animals are not sufficient for a burnt offering. (Isaiah 40:16)
