And they will have to know that I am Yehowah when I set a fire in Egypt and all its helpers are actually broken.

- Are you putting out of Your mind the calamitous day, and do You bring near the dwelling of violence? (Amos 6:3)
- Yet Yehowah's day will come as a thief, in which the heavens will pass away with a hissing noise, but the elements being intensely hot will be dissolved, and earth and the works in it will be discovered. (2 Peter 3:10)
- Since all these things are thus to be dissolved, what sort of persons ought You to be in holy acts of conduct and deeds of godly devotion. (2 Peter 3:11)
- Awaiting and keeping close in mind the presence of the day of Yehowah, through which the heavens being on fire will be dissolved and the elements being intensely hot will melt! (2 Peter 3:12)
- But there are new heavens and a new earth that we are awaiting according to his promise, and in these righteousness is to dwell. (2 Peter 3:13)
- You, therefore, beloved ones, having this advance knowledge, be on Your guard that You may not be led away with them by the error of the law-defying people and fall from YOUR OWN steadfastness. (2 Peter 3:17)
- This is what Yehowah has said; The supporters of Egypt must also fall, and the pride of its strength must come down. From Migdol to Syene they will fall in it even by the sword, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (Ezekiel 30:6)
- On account of the day that is coming to despoil all the Philistines, to cut off from Tyre and from Sidon every survivor that was helping. For Yehowah is despoiling the Philistines, who are the remaining ones from the island of Caphtor. (Jeremiah 47:4)
- And in Tehaphnehes the day will actually grow dark, when I break there the yoke bars of Egypt. And in her the pride of her strength will actually be made to cease. As for her, clouds

themselves will cover her, and into captivity her own dependent towns will go. (Ezekiel 30:18)
